

Surya Venkat Mam**, who has been associated with the project since 1984, the clinic continues to serve the community with unwavering commitment. *The project also benefits from the continued support of Dr. Rita & Spouse Dr. William Bhatnagar as consulting doctors and part sponsorship by the Venkat family.* Regular health awareness programmes and the Annual Baby Show further strengthen the clinic's impact on the community.




