A Board of Directors Meeting was conducted in order to discuss the finances and the upcoming projects for March.

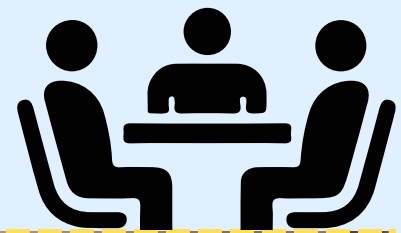


# HOLI MILAN

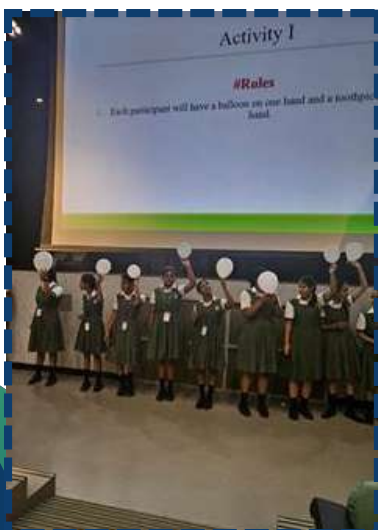




## 2. SEMINAR ON MENTAL HAPPINESS
