
- Wholistic, measurable and sustainable development in a focused manner to bring about magic in the lives of our beneficiaries.

PROJECTS DONE IN THE MONTH OF JULY

COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT

Date: 01st July , 2024 | Venue: Tupudang Village

"AYUSHMANN CARD YOJNA" SCREENING

To kick off the new term, a health camp was organized at Village Tupudang, screening around 350 residents for the government-launched "Ayushman Card Yojna." Villagers were informed about the benefits of the Ayushman Card, and 25 residents without the card were identified. We plan to hold a registration camp with the help of City Administration to ensure they receive their cards. The event was well-supported by Village Mukhiya ji and BDO.



PROJECT POSITIVE HEALTH
