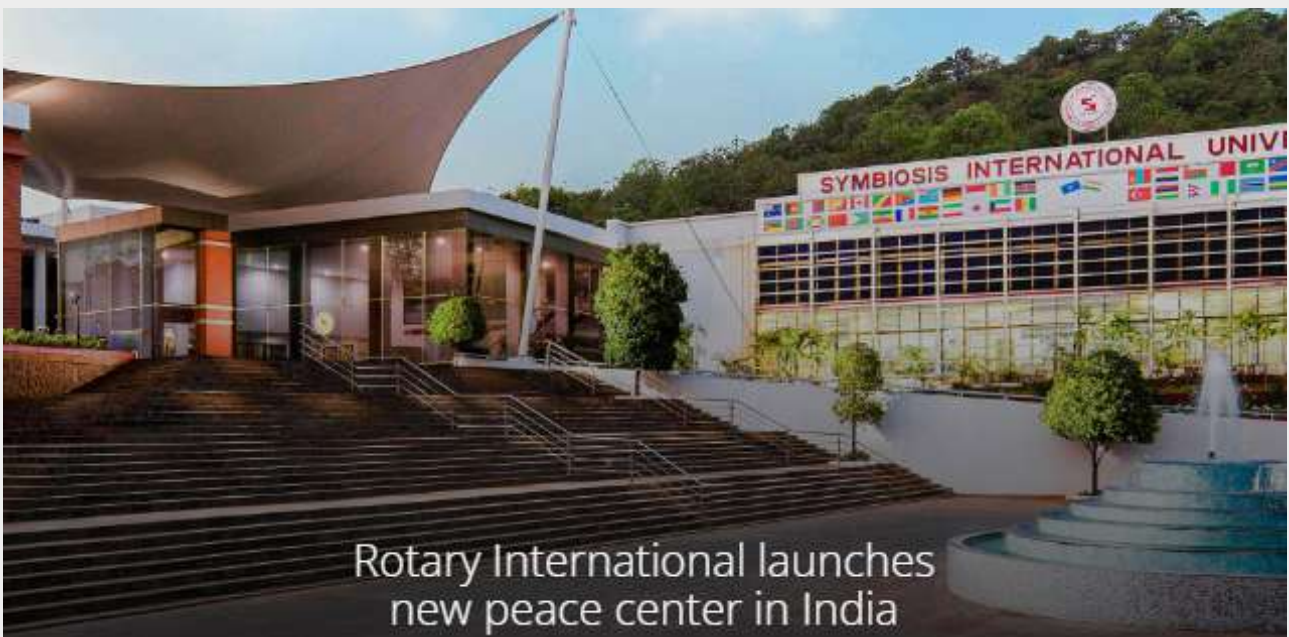

## Overview

On World Polio Day 2025, Rotary International supported the Global Polio Eradication Initiative alongside World Health Organization, UNICEF, and Gavi through global awareness and vaccination drives.

Rotary also strengthened milk banks in the Philippines after Typhoon Haiyan with support from The Rotary Foundation, and launched a new Peace Center at Symbiosis International University to train future peace leaders.

## Rotary Peace Center Opens in Pune



Rotary International and Symbiosis International University have launched a Rotary Peace Center in Pune with support from The Rotary Foundation.

The center will train 40 Asian professionals each year in peace and development, strengthening regional and global peacebuilding efforts.

## World Polio Day & Polio Eradication Efforts

World Polio Day was observed globally on 24 October 2025. Rotary clubs worldwide organized awareness walks, fundraising events, vaccination drives, and public campaigns to support the Global Polio Eradication Initiative in partnership with WHO, UNICEF, and Gavi.



## Global Rotary Projects & Awareness Campaigns

Throughout November 2025, Rotary members conducted innovative projects such as awareness road trips, benefit concerts, and community engagement programs across Europe, Africa, Asia, and the Americas to promote peace, health, and education.



## Milk Banks: A Lifeline for Vulnerable Newborns

After Typhoon Haiyan struck in 2013, Dr. Jose Fabella Memorial Hospital rushed 86 liters of donated breast milk to fragile newborns in Tacloban.

Recommended by the World Health Organization and UNICEF, donor milk is the safest option for premature and low-birth-weight babies when mothers cannot breastfeed.

With support from the Rotary Foundation and partners, the Philippines has expanded milk banks to 39 hospitals—giving vulnerable infants a stronger start in life.

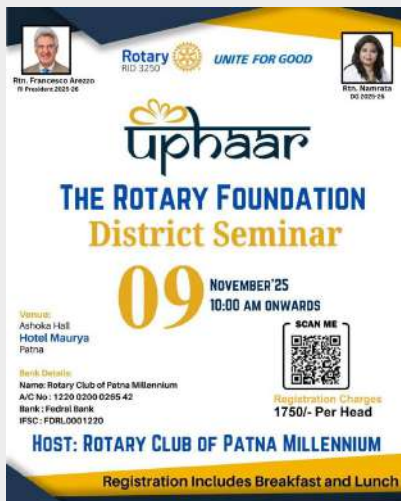

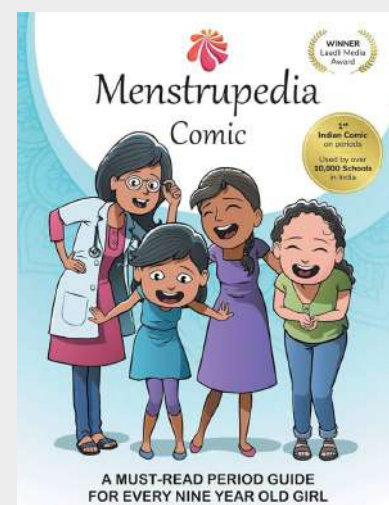


## Rotary Foundation District Seminar – “UPHAAR”

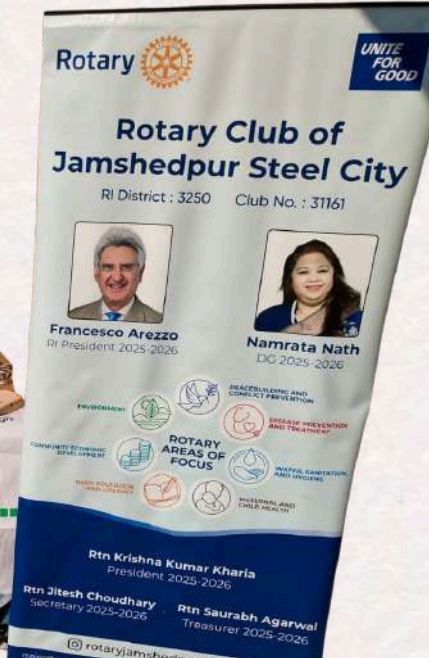


## E-Waste Collection Drive

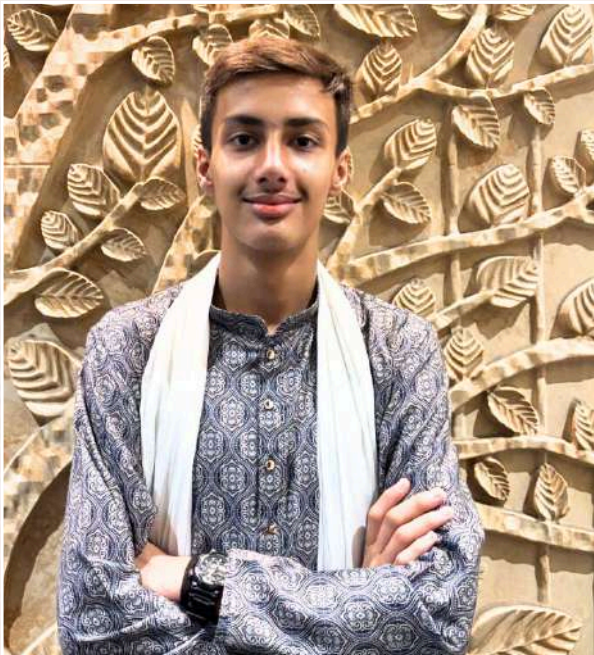
# Rotarylet Achievement

# Rotary Spouse Achievement



Participating in Ironman Goa for the second time came with both familiarity and fresh challenges. I began training nearly six months in advance, feeling more confident than the year before. But with work, travel, and a bit of overconfidence, I missed a few key sessions—something I could deeply feel on race day.

The swim was smooth—I was out in 47 minutes and feeling strong. I had planned a conservative ride to save my legs for the run, correcting a mistake from last year. But by the 50th kilometer, my quads were screaming. The missed workouts showed up.

When the run began, I was struggling. Severe cramps slowed me down to an 11 min/km pace. Slowly, I found rhythm again—eventually finishing the 21 km run with an 8 min/km pace and a final time of 7:43.

This race was a reminder: there's no shortcut for consistency. Confidence is good, but it can't replace daily effort. Ironman 2025 taught me more about training, resilience, and humility than I could have imagined. And I'm already looking ahead to the next one.
