District Governor Rtn. Bipin Chachan, a member of the Rotary Club of Pa taliputra, born in a business family in Muzaffarpur. His blood group is R positive. He completed his master's from Delhi School of Economics. He es tablished Plant Remedies Pvt Ltd, a manufacturing unit of Pesticides, in Ha jipur. Joined Rotary in 2007 and became the Club President in 2013-14 and during his tenure, he made RC Pataliputra the first 100% PHF club of Bihar. He launched the Mukti Rath project in Patna which has been successful to date. The club got the 'Best Club of the District' recognition.

DG Bipin Chachan stepped up to the district in 2015-16 as an Assistant Governor, The Rotary Foundation, after that he served our District as Zonal AG, District Paul Harris Society Coordinator, District Membership Chair, District Secretary-General, District Grants Sub-Committee Chair, District Water & Sanitation Chair, District Community Service Chair as well as District Stew ardship Chair.

During his service until now, he has happily received Rotary International's 'Avenues of Service' award, 'The Best Rotarian Couple' award, 'Best District Chairman' and 'Best AG' of the district.

DG Bipin Chachan has served as the lead person in a lot of Global Grants including three Rotary Dialysis Centres, a Rotary Blood Bank with a Cell Separator, a Rotary Eye Hospital, and a Ventilator and Dialysis Machine at Ma havir Heart Hospital in Patna. During the COVID-19, he arranged oxygen cylinders for various clubs in the district. He also built Oxygen Concentrator Bank by crowd funding and provided concentrators to various clubs.

He initiated the concept of young generation clubs like Pataliputra NextGen. He is a Paul Harris Society (PHS) member as well as a Major Donor.

Spouse Past President Shilpi Chachan, is an active Rotarian and has served the district as Assistant Governor and District Secretary-General. His eldest son Kunal has joined the business with his father and is also a Rotarian. The younger son Kushal is a computer engineer and works in AMD, a leading company of chips manufacturer in Texas and adores his parents' philanthropic outlook.
