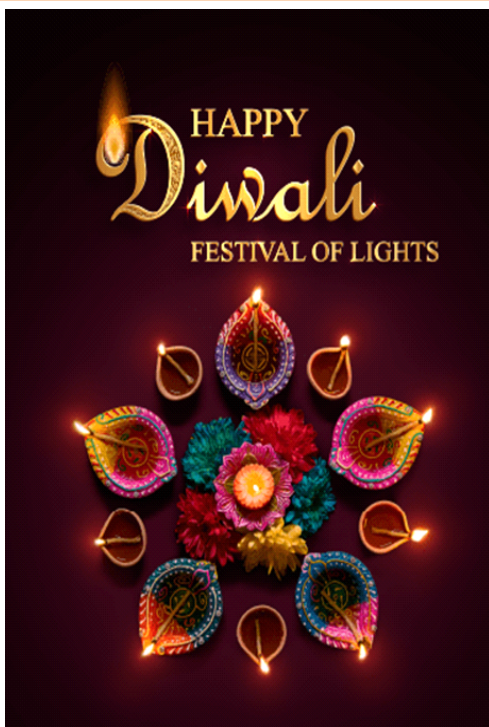

Recognize members for their efforts with the Avenues of Service award

When Rotary members take the time and make the effort to engage with their club, community, or others, they are volunteering their time, energy, and other resources without an expectation for anything in return. Recognizing members for their efforts lets them know that they are valued and appreciated.

Club presidents can honour their members for efforts such as serving on a committee, leading activities, helping other members, and growing their club by [nominating](#) them for one or more of the Avenues of Service awards, at any time during the Rotary year. Nominations are forwarded to district governors who review and determine eligibility. Once members have received recognition in all Avenues of Service, governors can nominate them for the [RI Avenues of Service award](#).

The Avenues of Service Award from Rotary International recognizes Rotary and Rotaract members who have achieved all five of Rotary's Avenues of Service. As governor, you nominate qualifying members from your district. If they are determined to be eligible, you will receive a pin and crystal to present to each member being honored. Nominations are reviewed three times each year, in October, April and July. You may submit as many as 10 nominations per period, for a maximum of 30 nominations during the Rotary year. The processing periods are below:

- 1 July to 30 September (processed in October)
- 1 October to 31 March (processed in April)
- 1 April to 30 June (processed in July)

Your participation in this survey is voluntary. By continuing, you are agreeing to share information with Rotary International and The Rotary Foundation (collectively "Rotary"). The personal data you share will only be used for official Rotary business. This means that the personal data you provide will primarily be used for processing this award nomination and stored in Rotary's archives if your nominee is selected.

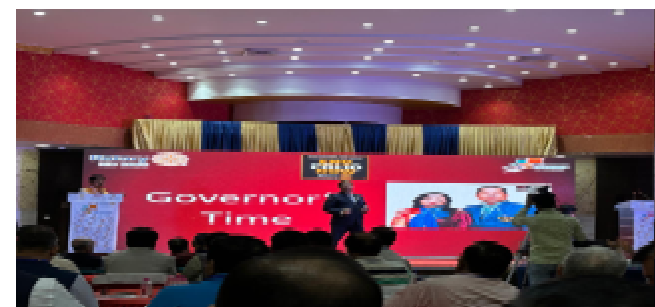
