Board decisions

October 2024

The 2024–25 RI Board of Directors met on 14–16 October 2024 at One Rotary Center in Evanston, Illinois, USA and reviewed 15 committee reports and recorded 53 decisions .

Club and District

The Board

in celebration of Rotary’s 125th anniversary, adopted a worldwide Rotaract membership growth goal of 125,000 Rotaractors by 1 July 2030;

revised the Grow Rotaract Operational Plan to better facilitate a smooth a member’s transition from Rotaract to Rotary club membership, while also strengthening collaboration between Rotary and Rotaract clubs;

agreed that the purpose of Rotaract is to give young leaders the unparalleled opportunity to develop their leadership skills and further, in support of this purpose, encouraged clubs to put the following policy into practice:

Clubs should seek out past Rotaractors and other younger persons who are qualified for membership. Clubs should find methods of increasing the appeal of membership to young men and women who demonstrate good character, integrity, and leadership; possess good reputation within their business, profession, occupation and/or community; and are willing to serve in their community and/or around the world.

Clubs may waive club dues and admission fees for members under the age of 35. In addition, clubs may provide payment of district dues for new members in this age group, and/or, by action at an assembly or conference, districts may reduce the per capita district dues for new members in this age group.

Programs and Awards

The Board

agreed to the creation of a fundraising partnership with the Paul & Jean Harris Home Foundation (PJHFF) and established the following guidelines for the partnership:

the partnership will begin upon execution of a partnership agreement between RI and the PJHFF and end on 30 June 2027;

all contributions in support of this partnership must be sent directly to the PJHFF. Any donation sent to RI, TRF, or to an associate foundation will be returned to the donor; the PJHFF must raise at least \$150,000 before RI will incur any campaign-related expenses;

all contributions received for this campaign must be used: first, to reimburse RI for the campaign expenses RI incurs; second, to repay the outstanding mortgage balances plus interest the PJHFF owes RI and the Rotary/One Foundation

consistent with the loan documents; third, to hold all remaining funds in perpetuity, invest them to generate spendable earnings, and use the spendable earnings solely for the operating expenses and long-term maintenance of the Paul and Jean Harris Home; renewed Rotary's partnership with the Peace Corps through October 2027; discontinued the official designation of "collaborating organization"; revised its policy on the Rotary Award for Excellence in Service to Humanity to clarify only non-members are eligible for the award.

accepted the preliminary program of events and activities for the 2026 Rotary International Convention to be held on 13-17 June in Taipei, Taiwan.
