



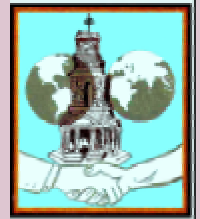

Rotary International's birthday is February 23, which is the day in 1905 when the first Rotary club was formed in Chicago.

#### How it started

- Chicago attorney Paul Harris formed the Rotary Club of Chicago in 1905.
- The club was formed to allow professionals with different backgrounds to exchange ideas and form friendships.
- The club was started by a small group of business people who wanted to do business with people who had good ethics.

#### How it has grown

- Rotary International has grown from a single club in Chicago to an organization in over 200 countries and territories.
- Rotary is a non-religious and non-political organization.
- Rotarians work to make the world a healthier and more peaceful place.

To celebrate Rotary's birthday (February 23rd), Rotary clubs and districts can organize events that highlight Rotary's service, achievements, and values, such as hosting service projects, community events, or fundraising activities, and promoting Rotary's work through social media and local media.

#### Here are some ideas for celebrating Rotary's birthday:

##### Community and Service-Oriented Events:

- Host a Service Project:  
Organize a project that aligns with Rotary's areas of focus, such as literacy, water and sanitation, or disease prevention.
- Organize a Fundraiser:  
Hold a fundraiser to support Rotary's global initiatives, such as PolioPlus or the Rotary Foundation.
- Celebrate with a Community Event:  
Organize a Rotary Day event in your town, inviting the community to participate in a walk, run, or other activity.
- Host a Screening of "The Final Inch":  
Show the documentary about Rotary's efforts to eradicate polio, followed by a panel discussion.
- Initiate a Local Contest:  
Organize a poster or essay contest promoting volunteerism and Rotary's values.
- Create a Rotary Day Podcast:  
Create a podcast with Rotarians discussing service projects and post it on your website or blog

### Promotional and Awareness Activities:

- Update Club/District Websites and Social Media: Share photos and videos from your celebrations, and highlight Rotary's work.
- Work with Local Media: Publicize Rotary Day events and achievements in local newspapers and on social media.
- Conduct a Billboard Campaign: Highlight Rotary's service locally and globally.
- Declare a Rotary Day: Work with your local chamber of commerce to declare a Rotary Day in your town.
- Share Rotary's History and Achievements: Reflect on Rotary's history and the impact of its service projects.
- Share Rotary's Values: Remind members and the community of Rotary's core values, such as service, integrity, and world understanding.
- Invite Potential Members: Use the celebration as an opportunity to share the work of Rotary clubs with potential members

Every year, people lose billions to scammers pushing fake investment schemes, posing as family members, or pretending to represent legitimate companies (and even Rotary leaders). Watch out for scams:

Imposter scams: Don't respond to texts or social media DMs that claim to be from a customer service department, the government – or even Rotary. Don't respond to unsolicited messages. Only contact organizations through their official URLs.

Wrong number texts: Don't interact with someone who seems to be texting you by mistake. They may be trying to establish a relationship so they can get your personal info.

Links and attachments: Don't click links or open email attachments unless they're expected and from an established, trusted contact.
