The DRFC's primary goal is to promote and support The Rotary Foundation's mission within a specific Rotary district.

In Rotary International, the **District Rotary Foundation Committee (DRFC)** is a key body that serves as a liaison between The Rotary Foundation and Rotarians,

assisting in educating, motivating, and inspiring Rotarians to participate in

Foundation grant and fundraising activities within the district.

Here's a more detailed breakdown of the DRFC:

Composition:

The DRFC is typically led by a District Rotary Foundation Committee Chair (DRFCC). The District Governor (DG) serves as an ex-officio member of the DRFC and its subcommittees.

Other members may include chairs of various subcommittees, such as grants, stewardship, PolioPlus, fundraising, and peace fellowship/scholarship advisory. Club representatives from the highest per capita and total Annual giving clubs may also be included.

Responsibilities:

Educating and motivating Rotarians about The Rotary Foundation and its programs. Supporting fundraising efforts for The Rotary Foundation.

Ensuring compliance with The Rotary Foundation's grant requirements and policies. Serving as a liaison between The Rotary Foundation and Rotarians within the district.

Training

DRFC is appointed to serve a 3-year term by the incoming District Governor every 3 years, and that appointment is approved by the Trustees of The Rotary Foundation. The DRFC must be familiar with the workings of each Foundation Sub-Committee.

The Rotary Foundation (TRF) is a separate arm of Rotary International. TRF is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization, and the funds contributed to TRF are used for funding educational, vocational and humanitarian programs. As an example, when your club donates \$1,000 to the Annual Programs Fund, after 3 years, 1/2 of that amount (\$500) goes into the World Fund to be used for Global Grants, and the other 1/2 (\$500) is returned to the District to be administered by the District and used for funding Grants applied for by Clubs for their various projects.
