

In Rotary International, the Council on Legislation (COL) is a three-year governing body that acts as Rotary's "Parliament". Its primary function is to deliberate and vote on proposed amendments to Rotary's constitutional documents, which include the Standard Rotary Club Constitution, the RI Constitution, and the RI Bylaws. Essentially, the COL ensures that Rotary's governance structures and policies are kept up-to-date and relevant.

Governance: The COL reviews and acts on proposed enactments (changes to constitutional documents) and resolutions (opinions or recommendations).

Representation: Each Rotary district sends a representative to the COL, ensuring a broad range of perspectives from Rotary clubs and districts. The duties of the representative are:

- to help clubs prepare proposals for COL
- to ensure these are discussed at the District conference or other meetings,
- to know the various opinions of Rotarians in the District on any proposals to be discussed at COL
- to attend the COL to consider and vote on items of legislation proposed to the Council
- to report back to the District following each COL they attend.

Decision-Making: The COL has the power to amend Rotary's core governing documents, making it a crucial part of the organization's governance process.

Evolution of Rotary: Significant changes in Rotary's structure and policies, such as the admission of women and the creation of the PolioPlus program, have been the result of COL actions.

Efficiency: A pre-voting process is used to vet proposed enactments, making the COL more efficient by focusing on items with widespread support or opposition.
