- Purpose: It helps in shaping laws and public policies by interpreting the Constitution in a forward-thinking manner that suits contemporary societal needs.
- Key Powers: Under Article 32 (Supreme Court) and Article 226 (High Courts), judicial activism is exercised.
- Outcomes: Judicial Activism has given rise to



Public Interest Litigations (PILs), the legal aid movement, and enhanced human rights protections.

 Judicial Responsibility: The judiciary is expected to uphold human dignity, freedom of speech, the rule of law, and constitutional democracy. Judges must be creative in interpreting the law to fill gaps and serve justice.

### Judicial Creativity:

- Definition: Judicial Creativity is the process by which judges develop new legal principles when existing statutes or laws fall short. It involves filling legal gaps through reasoned interpretation of the law.
- Role in Democracy: Judicial creativity is seen as essential to maintaining a functioning democracy, as it adapts legal principles to evolving social needs and ensures justice for all.

### Notable Examples:

- 1. Judicial Activism:
- PILs: Popularized by Justice P.N. Bhagwati through initiatives like the "postcard method."
- Kesavananda Bharati Case: Introduction of the Basic Structure Doctrine, preventing Parliament from amending the Constitution's fundamental features.
- Reservation Cases: Landmark judgments such as those in M. Nagaraj and Zornel Singh cases shaped India's policy on reservations.
- 2. Judicial Creativity:
- Catch-up Principle: Governs seniority in promotions between reserved and



- unreserved community employees.
- · Freedom of Speech: Interpreted to include the "freedom of silence."
- · Bail with Conditions: For example, mandating community service as a condition of bail.
- Changes in Court Practices: Judicial orders such as allowing online access to court orders during COVID-19.
