

EDITORIAL



Dear Friends in Rotary,

Happy Rotary greetings to all of you.

Area of Focus for this month of October by the Rotary International is 'Economic and Community Development'. This month also includes: International Day for the

Eradication of Poverty on the 17th and World Polio Day on the 24th of October. As suggested by Rotary the Rotarians mostly focuses on the work to reduce poverty and strengthen local economies by providing vocational training, necessary equipment, and to coordinate in getting microloans etc.

The first step in community development programme is to create RCCs. A Rotary Community Corps (RCC) is a group of non-Rotarians who share our commitment to changing the world through service projects. RCC members plan and carry out projects in their communities in collaboration with local Rotary clubs. Sponsored by a Rotary club, an RCC leverages Rotary's network, brand, and mentorship by partnering with clubs to plan and implement service projects. RCCs increase Rotary's impact and expand its reach by bringing the knowledge and talents of local people to strengthen their community through sustainable projects. RCCs are active everywhere wherever Rotary is present: in urban and rural areas, and in both developed and developing countries.

The present status of RCCs worldwide from the 2023 RCC survey by the RI is: 12,903 RCCs were active during the 2022-23 Rotary year, 54% of RCCs are in urban areas and 46% are in rural areas, 79% of RCCs meet at least once a month, 36% of RCC members are 40-50 years of age, 30% are 30-40 years of age, 18% are 50 and older, and 17% of RCC members are 18-30 years of age, 43% of RCCs have female predominantly members, 36% predominantly male members, and 21% equal number of female and male members. India has the highest number of active RCCs with 6,806 corps. The Philippines has the second highest number of RCCs with 2,174 corps. Egypt is in the third place with 669 RCCs, followed by Brazil with 371, and Turkey with 286.

RCCs are community organizations that also helps in developing new leaders in the society. To join an RCC, one must be an adult in the community, he/she should share Rotary's commitment to service, and not be a Rotary member. If we will go to the history of our club we have created number of RCCs in and around Bhubaneswar. We have conducted number of programmes in different Health, hygiene, sanitation, RCCs. development, vocational training were the prime areas on which our club had worked there. The most important aspect is keeping continuity in RCCs. Our previous club leaders tried their level best to bring community development projects and for which the RCSP (Rotary Community Service Project) was formed. As per the initial byelaw of RCSP dedicated club leaders (usually elected by the club) were looking after the RCSP for a period of 3 years which was instrumental in keeping continuity of programmes in RCCs. Due to increasing programmes, demand of RI and the society the club leaders (President, Secretary and Treasurer etc.) are devoting their fulltime for the day-to-day club activities. Now the situation has worsen. Many of our club leaders neither they can name the RCCs which belongs to our club nor they have ever visited to those RCCs. Most probably our club is the only club in our district having highest number of RCCs. At majority of RCCs our club had constructed Community Centre (RCC buildings) and were dedicated to those community for different type of activities.

Now it is high time to rethink about the revival of old system of RCSP, otherwise everything will run on pen and paper only. Our past president committee which constitute a sizable number of members can throw some light on this aspect. At present there are very few members present in the club who are aware of existence of all of our RCCs. When all of our members will get opportunity to visit at least once to our old RCCs definitely they will feel proud about the heritage of our club.

With this I conclude my column today. Meet you again with a new topic in the next month. Till then Good Bye.

Community development is ultimately about improving and simplifying the quality of life for all. Together in Rotary, we continue to build a world grounded in understanding and collaboration, thus building a better future.

Young adults aged 18-25 have the highest prevalence of mental illness at 36.2%. Female have a higher prevalence of mental illness than males at 26.4% compared to 19.7%. The age-adjusted Suicide rate per 1000,000 population is 21.1. To address the issues the ASHA WELLNESS CENTRE started by Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar in collaboration with MANAM Foundation. The centre was inaugurated by RI President last year during his visit to Bhubaneswar. The renovation of the building was done by Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar with Rs 5.00 lakhs and running expenditure through CSR grant and DDG. The present services provided are Psychiatric/ Counselling/ Assessments and Day Care Services (online and offline). Tele-counselling Helpline Service Number-08035376706 (10AM to 6 PM). Therapy services for stress/ depression and anxiety issues. Yoga and relaxation therapy. Deaddiction consultation. Further, we need awareness through

hoardings, leaflets, workshops etc. Under GG Project Saving Babies and Mothers, Kalahandi was inaugurated on 2nd October, 2024. He shared updates about the inauguration of the GG Project Saving Babies and Mothers and the provision of OT, ICU, and medical facilities to Projecst partner Swasthya Swaraj Society, Kaniguma, Kalahandi District. international partner is Rotary Club of Miami airport and the host clubs are Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar, Rotary E-club, Rotary Club of Bhawanipatna and Rotary Club of Mumbai Sobo. Address by Dr Prayash Rath (PT) on the Topic Developmental Problem in children-early detection and early intervention: Dr Prayash Rath (PT)in his address gave data of developmental delays occur 10% -15% of children under age 5 years. This delay could be transient or permanent leading to developmental disabilities. Causers are prenatal (Issues during pregnancy), perinatal (Complications during birth) and postnatal (Health challenges after birth). The Common developmental disorders are cerebral palsy, autism spectrum disorders, attention deficit hyperactive disorders, reading & writing difficulties, disorder of speech & hearing, down's syndrome and other neuromotor disorders. Early detection through Milestone Chart like respond to sound making sounds in 6 months, says Mama and Baba in 12 months, walks without help in 18 months, kicks ball and points to toys or pictures in 2 years, copies adults, plays with dolls, animals and people in 3 years and stand on one foot for up to five seconds, uses 5-6-word sentences, draws circles and squares in 4 years of age. In any deficiency early intervention required like physiotherapy for children, occupational

therapy for children, physiotherapy for adults, speech therapy, language training, early stimulation therapy, special education and cognitive behavioural therapy. Timely therapy can prevent disability and permanent brain damage. Dr. Prayash Rath emphasized the healing potential of early detection and appropriate therapy. His focus is on providing a range of therapeutic services for children and adults with neurological disorders, reinforcing that early intervention is the key to preventing lifelong disabilities.
