

FROM PRESIDENT'S DESK



Dear Fellow Rotarians

Our new Rotary year began on an auspicious note with the celebration of Maternal and Child Health Month in

July. It is always important to reflect on our objectives and the purpose behind focusing on this critical issue. Ensuring high-quality health care for vulnerable mothers and children is pivotal for fostering stronger and healthier communities. Women empowered is indeed family empowered. Additionally, quality child care fosters a healthier, more productive society by mitigating early life risks, enhancing future opportunities, and ensuring foundational development of the next generation. Rotary is committed to expanding access to quality care, empowering mothers, and nurturing healthy futures for children worldwide. Every year, millions of children lose their lives due to preventable causes such as malnutrition, inadequate health care, and poor sanitation. Rotary actively supports the betterment of health and well-being of mothers and their children.

The members of our Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar recognize this as one of our seven pillars to prioritize. Through our collective efforts, we strive towards making profound impact on our health systems. Keeping this in mind, we also organized Speaker's Sessions by Dr. Sasmita Dash and Dr. Palash Das. Dr. Dash, duringher session, emphasized on Women's Health. She shed light on the causes of maternal deaths, with Anaemia being the most prevalent reason, followed by Sepsis. There are innumerable women who die of childbirth. Unsafe abortion, increase in uterus and breast cancer, female foeticide, all of these have been rising. However, there is a very evident gap in the effectiveness of our healthcare infrastructure and the awareness amongst the multitude. Adolescent girls, being a very vulnerable group, empowering them by focusing on their health, menstrual hygiene, nutrition, and education is integral. Further more, she drew attention to the myths and the actual risk factors associated with cancer, and concluded by stressing on the importance of a balanced diet and exercise. Dr. Das focused his talk on the essential strategies for child health and development. Starting with the Dos during the gestational period, through the early years of child birth, he suggested ways of ensuring developmentally supportive care, required vaccinations, and ways of building a positive environment for the child.

Raising awareness about the importance of this issue and the preventive measures, our club remains steadfast in its commitment to this cause. Let us continue our dedicated work in ensuring that every mother and child has the opportunity to lead a healthy and fulfilling life. Together, we can make a difference in this and numerous other aspects.

Minutes of the 1st Executive Committee Meeting of RCSP for The RY 2023-24, held on Dtd 13.12.2023 at Rotary Bhawan (5:30 PM)

- The Meeting was called to order by Chairman Rtn. Manik Chand Sharma.
- The Chairman welcomed all members and expressed his grief for the delay in RCSP meeting.
- Thereafter he invited PP Rtn. Venugopal Rao to speak regarding the Global Grant Project of RCSP, i.e., Rotary Mobile Eye Screening Van.
- The discussion involved certain private contribution to be received for the same at RCSP. The beneficiaries will be availed 80G certificate against their contribution and the fund will be routed to Rotary Foundation through District Office against the particular global grant.
- * Following this, discussions took place on Mental Health Project in ASHA Building. PP Rtn. RG Agarwal said that approximately Rs. 6 Lakhs will be required for the project and approval of a contribution amounting to Rs. 5 Lakhs from RCSP Account was agreed upon.
- It was brought up that the Rotary Bhawan rent collection amount is falling short. In this regard, the Chairman said its reason to be some disciplinary action in the booking of Rotary Bhawan has been taken to safeguard the image of the Bhawan.
- Regarding Rotary School on Wheels, the Board has already taken the decision of its discontinuation from September. The Chairman, reiterated the same in this meeting to update all members. The cheque from July – September has also been prepared and will be hand overed.

- About the Happy School Kalapita, Rtn. Saroj Kumar Mohapatra said that a washroom for boys' and teachers' is to be constructed in the same. The estimated cost involved will be Rs. 1.5 Lakhs, out of which Rs. 1 Lakh will be given by Mo School. Remaining Rs. 50,000 has been contributed by our members as joy of giving, out of which PP Rtn. Sajjan Surekha graciously made a contribution of Rs. 25,000.
- Discussions regarding the quitting of the caretakers of Rotary Bhawan and ASHA Building and the further course of action then took place.
- PP Rtn. S.K. Das then talked about the Literacy Scholarship.
- A new podium and audio system is to be purchased for the Rotary Bhawan. The responsibility of the same was entrusted upon Rtn. Sanjay Choudhary and Rtn. Jnana Ranjan Rath respectively.
- The RCSP members suggested the oxygen cylinder purchased during peak Covid months should be kept with us in case of any emergencies.
- New account has been opened up for the Global Grant Project by PP Rtn. RG Agarwal and Rtn. Bijay Kumar Dash in the Union Bank of India.
- Discussions regarding the RCSP bylaw then took place and it was highlighted that some revisions in the bylaw was necessary at the earliest.
- Regarding the Green Chalk Board (for Saraswati Sisu Mandir school) contribution collected, the RCSP declined the same as





the process and channel of collection was improper and it was decided that the amounts will be refunded to the respective members.


Our members exchanged Club Flag in Japan
