I wish the occasion and publication all success.





Know your Club Advisor PDG DN Padhi, IAS (Retired)



Rtn. DN Padhi, IAS(R) is the former State Chief Information Commissioner, Odisha under the Right to Information Act, 2005, which was a quasi-judicial position. He was a Visiting Fellow at the Oxford University, UK for the academic year 1991-92 and possesses the degrees of M.Sc. (Physics) from Utkal University and MBA from Delhi University. He was recruited to the Indian Administrative Service in 1971. Prior to joining the IAS, he served the State Bank of India in New Delhi.

Rtn. Padhi is the recipient of the Prestigious Paul H. Appleby Award-2021 for Distinguished Service in the field of Public Administration of the Indian Institute of Public Administration (Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Govt. of India), New Delhi. This was presented by the Hon'ble Vice President of India.

To his credit it must be mentioned that he was the:

(a) Chairman of the National Task Force set up in 2004 by the Ministry of Finance, Government of India to revise/recast the General Financial Rules, 1964. His report was accepted and adopted by the Finance Ministry as General Financial Rules, 2006 which is in operation all over the country/ Embassies/High Commissions etc. of India,

- (b) Chairman of the National Working Group on "Convergence of Securities and Commodity Derivatives Markets" set up in 2004 by the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Government of India, New Delhi,
- (c) Member of the National Committee of the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi which finalized in 1993-94 and recommended the introduction of midday meals in the primary schools in the country,
- (d) Member of the National Task Force for introduction of District Primary Education Program (1993-94) assisted by the World Bank.

Some of the posts held by him were Principal Secretary, Energy (Power) Department, Principal Secretary, Steel and Mines, Special Relief Commissioner, Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Department of School and Mass Education, Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Tourism, Sports and Culture, apart from being the Founder Managing Director, Odisha Tourism Development Corporation (OTDC) and Founder of the Odisha Primary Education Program. He was the Collector and District Magistrate of Mayurbhanj district (Administrative Chief of the geographical area) which has almost 65% tribal population, the largest in any district in the State.

In the Indian Administrative Service (IAS), Rtn Padhi, apart from holding other very significant and important assignments in Odisha, has also served under Government of India as Director in the Ministry of Defense, Additional Secretary and Financial Advisor in the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution and for some time held additional charge as AS





& FA of the Planning Commission, Govt. of India, Ministry of **Statistics** and **Program** Implementation, Ministry of Agriculture and ICAR. He was the Special Secretary, Ministry of Power, New Delhi when he was unanimously selected as State Chief Information Commissioner, Odisha.

Rtn Padhi is a Rotarian since 1975 devoted to selfless voluntary service in the community and maintained perfect attendance till exempted in 2005. He is the recipient of Rotary International's Highest Award "Service Above Self" (1998-99), the coveted Citation for Meritorious Service (2000-01) and the Distinguished Service Award (2005-06), of the Rotary Foundation of the Rotary International. He is a Major Donor, Benefactor of the Rotary Foundation, Memorial Contributor and a Multiple Paul Harris Fellow.

He was the Governor of Rotary International District 3260 during 1996-97. Rtn Padhi was the President of the Rotary Club of Baripada in 1980-81 and the President of the Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar in 1984-85, when this Club was adjudged the Best Club in the Rotary District and he designated as the Best President.

He was a Member of the India National Polio Plus Society of Rotary International continuously for 18 years from 1997-98, till India was declared Polio Free by WHO and CDC, Atlanta, Georgia. He was a member of the Polio Plus GSE Team which visited RI District 9210 (Africa) in April 1999 and has received the prestigious Regional Service Award for Polio Free World in South East Asia from the Rotary Foundation of Rotary International and also the most prestigious International Service Award for Polio Free World. He was Advisor, Government Collaboration Committee of the Rotary India Literacy Mission.

His professional interests are in the areas of Energy Management, International Trade, Industrial Marketing, International Financial Management, Strategic Business Management, Human Resource Development, Tourism Management, Corporate Social Responsibility, Right to Information and Rights of the Child. He was the Chairman, Institute of Directors and Council for Corporate Governance (Odisha Chapter), former Chairman of the Indian Institute of Public Administration (Odisha Branch), Director, Centre for Strategic Initiatives in Public Administration (IIPA), Odisha, Advisor to the Odisha Branch of the World Wide Fund for Nature (India), Working President of the Metropolis Bhubaneswar Management Association and former National President, Indian Association of Kick Boxing Organizations.

His wife Prof. (Dr.) Deepa Padhi, Ph.D., D.Litt., taught Philosophy in a Govt. college. She is member of the Inner Wheel Club of Bhubaneswar and a Past President. Currently she is the President of the Theosophical Order of Service (Odisha Region), the philanthropic arm of International Theosophical Society and working for destitute homes and orphanages.

They are happily married and live united with their children and grand children.



stream for one year in Bangalore and then completed his graduation in Civil Engineering in Madras.

As a Khandayat Kshyatriya (Warrior) by caste he was very keen towards the physical fitness and fighting arts since his childhood and started his Karate training during his Engineering study in Madras and earned coveted Black Belt in 1984. He travelled to JAPAN in 1985 for higher training under Grand Master Late Ken-ei Mabuni and on his return Late Dr. Hare Krushna Mahatab honored him as the "The First Black Belt of Orissa" on the eve of International Youth Year at Saheed Bhawan, Cuttack. As a 8th Dan Black Belt Grandmaster Harichandan is highly experienced and Internationally qualified Referee/Judge/Coach in various Martial Arts such as Wushu, Kickboxing, Ju-Jitsu, Taekwondo & Karate from India, an unique achievement for any Indian. He credited to produce the "Youngest Black Belt of India" Master Varun Mahapatra from Bhubaneswar at the age of below Five years both in Karate & Kickboxing in January 2004 who received the "National Child Award"

from Hon'ble Union Minister, HRD Late Shri Arjun Singh in August 2005 in New Delhi. Till date he produced more than thousands Black Belts all over the country and overseas.

He introduced the Olympic recognized sport "WUSHU"- Chinese Martial Art in Odisha in1989 and qualified as

the first Indian "International Wushu Judge" in Kualalumpur, Malaysia in 1993. He served to "Wushu Association of India(WAI)" as Chief Judge for many years. Most importantly he conducted the "1st NIS SAI Coaches Course in Wushu ". as the Chief Coach appointed by Sports Authority of India (SAI) in 2000 and produced 10nos NIS Wushu Coaches among which his disciple PP Rtn Pradyumna Behera was the topper. As a pioneer he introduced KICKBOXING in India since 1993 and founded the National Kickboxing Federation i.e. IAKO functioning from Bhubaneswar, Odisha and made Kickboxing extremely popular among the youth to get job in Armed and Police units on priority. He produced many National, International and World Champions from Indian.

As a Rotarian he joined Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar in the year 1990 and served to the club in different avenues as Director including Secretary and became the President in 1999-2000 as the youngest President. Same year he got the opportunity to serve the victims of SUPER CYCLONE as well to the Community



in general. The situation was so disastrous that many noted Rotary International Leaders including the then RI President Elect Frank Devlin and his wife Ms. Gloria Rita, PRIP Raja Saboo, PRID Sudershan Agarwal, PRID Kalyan Banerjee and many Past RI Directors visited and extended hands for relief work. During his tenure the Up gradation of Blood Banks at Capital Hospital and Municipal Hospital under 3-H Project were also inaugurated by PRIE Frank Devlin. He served three terms as Asst. Governor in Dist. 3260 & 3262. He served three terms as President Elect during 1997-98-99 & 2020-21 and after 21 years of his President ship he has been again choosen to lead this premier club as the President for the Rotary Year 2021-22.

He is the founder of Rotaract & Interact Clubs of PUMAS and Rotaract Club of BCCM to provide an opportunity to the members in the field of Social Works with the objectives of Rotary International. He has attended most of the District Conferences and Assemblies regularly. A Brief History of Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar

In 1965, Bhubaneswar the capital city of Orissa was very young with a population of about fifty thousand. Within its periphery there were a few Govt. offices like Secretariat, State Assembly, AG's office, PMG's office, CRPF, and some Commercial concerns. Some institutions like, Orissa University of Agriculture and Technology, Regional College of Education, Regional Research Laboratory, BJB College, RD Women's College, Utkal University etc. also grew up with foreign aid giving the town an international touch. That was an era when Bhubaneswar faced a transition from a town to a city.

Towards 1964-65, Dr S. Lewis Land, a veteran Rotarian from U.S.A. came to Bhubaneswar to help in organizing Orissa University of Agriculture and Technology, which is the second Agriculture University of the country. It was Dr S. Lewis Land who took the initiative in forming a Rotary Club in the town. Prior to that regularly he was going to Cuttack for attending Rotary Club meetings and there he approached the senior Rotarians of Rotary Club of Cuttack for sponsoring a Club at Bhubaneswar.

Ultimately, the then District Governor of RID 325 Rtn. C. R. Bose appointed Rtn. KhatauSundar Das of Rotary Club of Cuttack as the Governor's Special Representative for organizing this new club at Bhubaneswar. The first organizational meeting of the Club was held at State Guest House on 28.2.1965 (Sunday) at 11 AM under the Chairmanship of DG. Rtn. C. R. Bose. Exactly after a week on the next Sunday i.e. on 7.3.1965 the second meeting, which was considered as the first meeting of the provisional Rotary Club, Bhubaneswar was held at the same venue under the Presidentship of Shri NilamaniSenapati to

elect the first Board of Directors. In that meeting Sri NilamaniSenapati, I.C.S. (Retd.) was elected as the Charter President and Sri Nalinikanta Panda, I.A.S. as the Charter Secretary. A luncheon was hosted by the Rotary Club of Cuttack at 1 P.M. on that occasion. The next meeting of the Club was held on Thursday, the 11th March, 1965 at 6.30 P.M. which was followed by a dinner hosted by Rtn. D.P. Gupta of M/s. Gupta Cables Ltd. All the required paraphernalia were completed and the survey report was sent to the Rotary International incorporating a list of 30 Charter members. Within a short span of one and a half month the club was admitted as a member of Rotary International on 11th May 1965 (which is considered as charter day).

On 19thJune, 1965 the charter presentation ceremony was held in the premises of Raj Bhawan with Dr. A. N. Khosla, Governor of the State of Orissa, as the Chief Guest. Rtn. C.R. Bose, Governor of R.I. Dist. 325 presented the charter to Rtn. NilamaniSenapati as Charter President. Along with thirty Charter members, four more members were also inducted by the District Governor as Rotarians on that day. Dr. Khoslawished that the Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar should rotate non-stop for the service to community but it should not function as a Roti Club indulging itself in food and drinks.

This club has the pride in nurturing some leaders for the District. It will not be out of place to mention here that an ex-member and Vice-President of our Club Dr. Sadashiv Mishra who consequent upon his transfer joined the Rotary Club of Cuttack could become District Governor of R.I.Dist. 326 during the year 1976-77 and another four members of this club viz.



Rtn.Dr.SreenivasaSahu (1988-89), Rtn. D. N. Padhi (1996-97), Rtn. N. K. Mishra (1998-99) and Rtn. Aswini Kumar Kar (2002-03) could also decorated the exalted office of the Dist. Governor of R.I. Dist. 3260. Recently, Rtn. Jayshree Mohanty, who was a member of this club since 2009-10 left this club and formed the Bhubaneswar Rotary e-club and got elected and served as DG for 2023-24 of RID 3262.

Venue: Initially the weekly club meetings were being held in the State Guest House. But, to run the club at a centrally located place, the venue had to be changed from July 1965 to the premises of Bhubaneswar Club Limited. There the weekly meetings were conducted up to December, 1967 and from January 1968 the club functioned in the State Red Cross Building for two years. Again the Board of Directors of the Club decided to re-shift the venue to the Bhubaneswar Club. Accordingly, since 1970, the Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar functioned till March 1992 in the Bhubaneswar Club building. Since April 1992 club's regular meetings are being held in our own building Rotary Bhawanin Sachivalay Marg on every Monday at 7 P.M.

Membership Growth: The club started with 30 charter members and on the date of presentation of charter, 34 members were decorated with lapel pins with four new inductions. In course of time many new names have come in and disappeared too from the Roster either due to transfer, change of place, ill-health, extraneous engagements or death. In the initial years there was practically no growth. Although some new members were coming in, the departure of a few old ones could not be stopped. By the end of June 1970, the net growth was nil, membership remaining stagnant at 30. This went up to 52 by the end of the next decade, i.e., June, 1980. The year 1988-89 ended on 30.6.89 with 81 members on the rolls. By the mid 1990-91, the membership went up to the record growth of 97 and came down again to 71 by 30.6.92. Thereafter the club memberships always remain more than 100. During 2007-08 it was the largest club of the district having more than 165 members.

Club Bulletin (KONARK): There was no regular bulletin published up to 1967-68. It was being occasionally brought out in the shape of souvenirs on the occasion of special functions such as Installation ceremony, District Governor's visit etc. The first issue of the bulletin was published on 17.7.1966under the editorship of Wing Comdr. Shehgal. From 1968-69, it came out in almost printed form with the title name of "KONARK" once in a month and that was also not regular. From the year 1976-77, the publication of the bulletin became regular in cyclostyled form with demy one-fourth size. Presently it comes out with beautiful get-up containing ample information on R.I., District and Club activities. KONARK in the meantime has won district award as best printed bulletin of the district in several years.

Sponsoring of New Rotary Clubs: The Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar has so far sponsored Rotary Clubs of Puri, Jatni, Khurda, and may other Rotary clubs at Bhubaneswar.

ROTARACT CLUB: The first community based Rotaract club was organized during the year 1970 at the children's park premises. Thereafterthe Rotaract Clubs were formed in Utkal University (VaniVihar)in 1976-77 followed by the clubs at BJB College and StewartSchool. Later number of Rotaract Clubs are addedand some also became defunct.

INTERACT CLUB: The Interact Club of St. Joseph Convent School was the firstinteract club to hold a certificate. Thereafter the clubs at DAV Public School, Unit-8 and Stewart School came in. Those





clubs howeverpresently not in action. Rather many other institutions now have Interact Clubs. The PUMAS martial art complex at Unit – 6 has got both Rotaract and Interact Clubs.

RCC: In our adopted villages at Dhauliand Daspur, Rotary Village Corps (Rotary Community Corps) have been organised during 1986-87 and 1987-88, respectively for all-round development of the individuals, and improvement of the community. The R.I.President M.A.T. Caparas paid a visitto RCCDhauli on 15.1.87 withRtn. RajendraSaboo, R.I. President(1991-92) and addressed the R.V.C. which was as we all know, his brain child.

R.I. President's Visit to the Club: It willbe worthwhile to mention here that our club had thesingular distinction of welcoming R.I. President MAT Caparasand Anne Nita, the First lady of Rotary in January, 1987. This was the first ever visit of an R.I. President to District 3260. On thisoccasion the then R.I. Director Rtn. RajaK. Saboo and Anne UshaSaboowere also greeted by our club.

ROTARY SUPPORTS INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

First let us understand that Education covers both the act of instructing and learning. There must be commitment from both sides. As you will appreciate you can take the horse to the river but you cannot make him drink. Hence we need to create an enabling environment to learn.

Inclusive Education is learning environment that promotes the full personal, academic and professional development of all learners irrespective of race, class, colour, gender, disability, sexual preference, learning styles and language. Rotary's contribution in the area of education is indeed commendable. Be it promoting schools or establishing happy schools, Rotary has a vital role in the area of education.

We need to create a supportive environment where all children are in the same classrooms and in the same schools. That means providing learning opportunities even for those groups who have traditionally been excluded.

Inclusive education means every child has the right to quality education and learning. There seems to be a dichotomy in this regard as the affluent can only reach the corporate run schools as the tuition fees are very exorbitant even for the middle class what to talk of the lower rung of the society.

Inclusive education is the most effective way to give all children a fair chance to go to school, learn and develop skills to thrive in life and be a partner in the development process of the country.

Disability is one of the most serious barriers to education across the globe. They face persistent barriers to education stemming from discrimination and stigma. Children with speech

disorder are indeed apt examples of discrimination in schools which needs to be rightly addressed.

We need to close the education gap for children with disabilities through advocacy, awareness raising, capacity building and support.

When you teach an adult illiterate tell him what benefits will accrue after being literate. You will definitely find him to be sincere and pains taking in completing his lessons.

I vividly recollect an incident where we requested a young rishkawalla in Bandamunda to join the adult literacy centre... he promptly questioned me what is my benefit of being literate. When I convinced him pertaining to better job opportunities and his contribution in the home front he joined the centre and was also very sincere and punctual.

After 3 months I again visited Bandamunda to take note of the progress in the literacy centre I was amazed to find Raju, the rishkawalla completing all the three phases of the literacy kit in record time. I only trust by now he has been able to fend a better job for himself.

I must say education by all means has a pivotal role in our development. Education for sustainable development empowers us to actions for environmental integrity, economic viability and a purposeful society. It facilitates us to develop anticipatory thinking, normative and strategic competence along with skills for problem-solving and collaboration.

The National Education Policy -2020 emphasizes that, education is the single greatest tool for achieving social justice and equality which has





implications for development of an inclusive community and society at large.

The NEP has infused the aspects of disability inclusion throughout the policy document with a dedicated chapter on equitable and inclusive education, focusing on issues, challenges and recommendations for inclusion of under represented student groups including children with disabilities has been subsumed in the policy and covered under the Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Groups which is indeed an

umbrella term covering gender identities, socioculturally and socio-economic identities, geographically identities as well as disabilities.

Inclusive education broadly advocates the teaching-learning environment to be welcoming and supports all learners regardless of learning styles, abilities and disabilities.

I am fairly optimistic that such endeavours on the part of Rotarians will immensely contribute towards a better world and purposeful living.
