



## Mr. Harakhchand Savla

### About Mr. Harakhchand Savla

The Jeevan Jyot Trust, founded by Mr. Harakhchand Savla, today runs more than 60 humanitarian projects across India. At 57 years of age, Mr. Savla works with the same passion and dedication that he had when he started at the age of 20.

Mr. Savla is a person of calmness and serenity, and serves as the Managing Trustee of the trust, which has expanded its presence to 12 different centres across the country, including Mumbai, Jalgaon, and Kolkata.

He credits much of his success and strength to his wife, who has been a constant source of support in all his activities. With a deep sense of social responsibility, he balances home, business, and humanitarian service seamlessly.

His sensitivity toward the needy was visible even during childhood. As a student, he would save his own bus fare to pay the school fees of a friend who couldn't afford them. He lives by the belief:

"Whatever the society has done for us, it is our duty to return that favour back to society."

In his youth, he formed an association in his local neighbourhoods and began laying the foundation of his mission through blood donation camps, free food distribution, medical aid, and supporting patients in need. He even helped perform last rites for unclaimed bodies, giving dignity to those who had no one.

While managing a library in Lower Parel, he developed a deep interest in literature and philosophy, which shaped his understanding of life and service. During that time, he began guiding people informally, which brought him to witness the harsh realities at Tata Memorial Hospital for the first time. Despite being a successful businessman, he felt a sense of emptiness and was moved by the sight of patients battling cancer and their families fighting despair.

This profound experience changed his life. He rented out his hotel, which was running successfully, and used those funds to start a charitable initiative just outside Tata Cancer Hospital, on the pavement near Kondaji Building.

What began humbly—providing food, shelter, medicines, and emotional support to cancer patients and their families—soon became a movement. Even he could not have imagined that this activity would continue for over 27 years.

Starting with just 50 beneficiaries, the numbers soon rose to 100, 200, 300, and today, over 700 people receive free meals daily. This selfless service continued regardless of season—whether it was the harsh summer, bitter winter, or the relentless Mumbai monsoon.

He also initiated a unique effort of collecting old newspapers, clothes, and household items door-to-door, and successfully raised ₹40 lakhs through this campaign—an example of how small actions can lead to great social impact.

Not just food, Mr. Savla also began supplying free medicines to patients. He founded a medicine bank, supported by three volunteer doctors and three pharmacists. A toy bank was also started for children undergoing cancer treatment, bringing them joy and comfort during difficult times.

Over the past 27 years, millions of cancer patients and their families have found hope, help, and healing—many even call him "God in human form."

Mr. Harakhchand Savla's contribution to society and the nation is a shining example of compassion, vision, and humanity in action.
