Er. G. K. Behera was born on 1940 at Jhanjiri Mangala Cuttack and matriculated from Ravenshaw Collegiate School, Cuttack. He secured his B. Engg. Degree from U. C. E. Burla in 1962 and joined the state PWD in 1963 as in-charge of the high-level bridge over the Mahanadi at Kaliaboda, Cuttack, then the longest bridge in India and retired in 1998 as E-i-C-cum-Secretary, Works Dept. he has been associated with bridge construction activities throughout his service tenure and even after retirement has been a consultant to many firms and to RVNL over Mahanadi and Luna rivers at Bhutmunde. He has supervised construction of the concrete highway from Cuttack to Paradip, also supervised construction of bridge at Chahata connecting Dhabaleswar to Cuttack, and at Badamba joining Baideswar with a right-angled bridge to Singhanath pitha which is currently the

states longest bridge and has constructed almost 16kms of bridge all over the state.

Settled at Mahanadi Vihar after retirement. He is responsible for the green cover of the locality having planned many fruit-bearing trees, has installed statues of Utkalamani & Utkalagourab and a double-storied hall in the campus of Women's College, Mahanadi Vihar.
