EDITORIAL

Fakir Mohan Senapati is regarded as the father of Odia Nationalism & Modern Odia Literature and also as the Utkala Byasa Kabi. He was an Indian writer, poet, philosopher and social reformer. He stimulated the linguistic movement to promote the Odia language. In the year 1866 he brought a Printing Press from Calcutta (Kolkata) in a Bullock Cart to Balasore to start the Odia language printing press. He wanted to preserve the 'Chalita Odia Bhasa' that is the spoken language without using Sanskrit or Bengali as a separate and independent language, it is called the 'Chasa' language. In his magazine "Utkala Deepika" he started publishing patriotic speeches, culture and articles.

One of his creations is "Srimati Samarjani / Patent Medicine." It is the story of urban society where he projects two categories of women and their conduct. One is 'the angel in the house' and the other is 'devil in the flesh'. The presentation of the characters and the cultural humor of the play never dies. But always a question arises in mind "Is the 'Broom' medicine wading out the drinking habit ???
