It is not believable that Dipak Bhai is no more with us since 17.10.25. He was so sociable, philanthropist and served in many esteemed public organisations in different leadership capacities. He was the President of our club in 1998-99, Vice-President-cum-Director of Utkal Chamber of Commerce & Industries Limited (UCCIL)for six years, Vice-President of Hotel & Restaurant Association of Odisha (HARO) for many years and President of Cuttack Guirati Samai etc.

He was known for his straightforwardness, boldness and delightful companion. At the same time, he was very soft in heart, warm in affection and loving in many lasting friendships. After completing his three years graduation course in Commerce from the then Ravenshaw College (now Ravenshaw University) he joined Hospitality Industry and founded the famous Ashoka Hotel near College Square, Cuttack. He was a thinktank for promotion of Tourism in Odisha and had been contributing in drafting of Odisha Tourism Policies from time to time in last four decades. He had a lion like personality in UC-CIL and as Director had advised to many Expert Committees for growth and prosperity of Business Communities in Odisha.

He was regular and a highly respected member of the Cuttack Club Limited, a heritage club of Odisha. He had maintained Championship for a no of years in Squash Tennis, a powerful game with perfect physical fitness.

He was the second most senior Rotarian of the prestigious and first Rotary Club Odisha, ie the Rotary Club of Cuttack. He was sincerely involved in permanent Projects of RCC. He had completed more than 45 years in Rotary. His entire family members were involved in Rotary, Inner Wheel and Rotaract. During his Presidentship in 1998-99, he made a record hosting of all Board meetings in his hotel conference room. His absence is a great loss not only to our heritage club but to our society in general.
