#### OUR GUEST SPEAKER



Sofia Firdous was born on 23rd August 1991, is an Indian politician and the first Muslim woman elected to the Odisha Legislative Assembly. She represents the Barabati-Cuttack constituency as a member of the Indian National Congress (INC).

Born in Cuttack, Odisha, she is the daughter of senior Congress leader and former MLA Mohammed Moquim. She completed her schooling at St. Joseph's Girl's High School and pursued higher secondary education at Ravenshaw Junior College. In 2013, she earned a Bachelor of Technology in Civil Engineering from Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT) University, Bhubaneswar. Later, in 2022, she completed an Executive

General Management program at the Indian Institute of Management Bangalore.

Before entering politics, she managed real estate and asset development businesses. She served as the president of the Confederation of Real Estate Developers Association of India (CREDAI) Bhubaneswar chapter.

Her political journey began in 2024 when she contested the Odisha Legislative Assembly election from the Barabati-Cuttack constituency. She succeeded her father, Mohammed Moquim. Her victory marked a historic milestone, making her the first Muslim woman MLA in Odisha.

Her election is seen as a significant step towards greater inclusivity and representation in Odisha's political landscape.
