Shri Susanta Kumar Biswal, born on 17 July 1965, is a seasoned police officer currently serving as Additional Superintendent of Police (Vigilance Directorate), Odisha, Cuttack. A postgraduate in Political Science (specialization in India's Foreign Affairs) from Berhampur University and M.B.A. (HRM), he also holds a PGDCA qualification. Joining Odisha Police in 1993 as Sub-Inspector, Shri Biswal rose through the ranks with exceptional dedication. He served as Officer-in-Charge in Rayagada and Kalahandi districts, earning "Best Officer-in-Charge of Kalahandi District" awards in 2001 and 2004. Promoted to Inspector of Police in 2006 and inducted into the Vigilance Organisation, he later became Deputy Superintendent and Additional SP. His illustrious career is adorned with the DGP Disc Medal (2011-12), President's Police Medal for Meritorious Service (Republic Day 2020), Best

Investigating Officer awards (Koraput Division 2020 & State 2022),

and the Governor's Police Medal (Republic Day 2025). With expertise in anti-corruption, cybercrime, and VIP security training, Shri Biswal remains a role model in Odisha Police.
