In Vietnam, she worked with clubs to help build a primary school and traveled to the Dominican Republic to install water filters. Urchick is currently helping to partner clubs and districts in the U.S. with Rotary clubs in Kosovo, Albania, and in Ukraine for humanitarian and educational services. Urchick wants to see 100,000 more Rotary members in 2024-25. She believes that the magic of Rotary happens at the club level, where the people are serving their communities. She is a Major Donor and a member of the Bequest Society of The Rotary Foundation.

JALDHARA PROJECT

11-August 2024

नदी पात्राच्या बाजूला रोटरीचा 'जलधारा प्रकल्प'

पृथा वीर, छत्रपती संभाजीनगर

चिकाठी वृक्षसंपदा लावून नदीचे पाणी वाहू नये म्हणून जिमनीची धूप थांबवण्यासाठी रोटरी क्लब 'जलधारा' प्रकल्प राबवित आहे. या प्रकल्पांतर्गत वैजापूर तालुक्यातील बाभूळतेल आणि लगतच्या नायगव्हाण गावात रोटरीने ग्रामस्थ आणि स्वयंसेवी संस्थेच्या मदतीने देसी झाडे लावली. या झाडांची काळजी व संगोपन स्वयंसेवी संस्था आणि ग्रामस्थ करणार असून पाझर तलावाच्या बाजूला असलेल्या चराच्या बाजला झाडे लावण्यात आली.

शहरात वेगवेगळ्या प्रकल्पांवर काम करणाऱ्या रोटरी क्लबने आता ग्रामीण भागात काम करण्यासाठी पुढाकार घेतला आहे. गावांचा शाश्वत विकास म्हणून रोटरी क्लबने जलधारा प्रकल्पाद्वारे इथल्या ढेकू नदी पात्राच्या बाजूला शुक्रवारी वृक्षारोपण केले. रोटरी क्लब, रोटरी इलाईट, रोटरी मिडटाऊन, रोटरी मेट्रो, रोटरी कॅन्टोन्मेन्ट, रोटरी सेंट्रल, रोटरी ईस्ट, रोटरी वेस्ट या कल्बने मिळून एक हजार झाडे दिली. संपूर्ण जिल्ह्यात दहा हजार झाडे लावण्यात येणार आहे. या वळी रोटरीने सर्वप्रथम बाभूळतेलच्या ग्रामस्थांशी संवाद साधला. रोटरीच्या असिस्टंट गव्हर्नर स्वाती स्मार्त आणि प्रमोद सावंत, मिडटाउनचे अध्यक्ष उल्हास मराठे, रोटरी क्लबचे रूस्तम तुपे, इलाइट क्लबचे अध्यक्ष चंद्रकांत भयवाल, अशोक देवरे, हसमुख सोमय्या, रामेश्वर पवार, दिव्या मराठे, मनोज देशमुख, भालचंद्र अत्रे, अपर्णा कुलकर्णी उपस्थित होत्या.

बाभूळतेलचे सरपंच अनिल कुळधर, उपसरपंच सुरेश काटे, शिवनाथ दारबंटे, ग्रामसेवक योगेश खांडगवरे, मराठवाडा ग्रामीण विकास संस्थेचे प्रकल्प समन्वयक ओंकार उगले, समृह संघटक संदीप जाधव, नायगव्हाणचे ग्रामस्थ अंबादास खोचे, पोलिस पाटील काशाबाई साईनाथ सोनवणे यांनी गावांची वैशिष्ट्ये सांगितली. १९६० लोकसंख्या असलेल्या बाभूळतेल गाव, ३९८ लोकसंख्या असलेल्या नायगव्हाण ही गाव दुष्काळी भागातच मोडतात. दोन वर्षांपूर्वी इथे कापुस, मका अशी खरीप पीक घेतली जायची.

शासकीय योजनांचा लाभ घेत ग्रामपंचायत, ग्रामस्थ आणि मराठवाडा ग्रामीण विकास संस्था मिळून बाभूळतेल





आणि नायगव्हाण गाव हद्दीतील ढेकू नदीचे मे २०२१ पासून खोलीकरण व रूंदीकरणाचे काम सुरू केले. पूर्वी नदीला पूर आल्यावर पाणी शेतात शिरायचे आणि नुकसान व्हायचे. नंतर पाणी पातळी कमी असायची, यामळे नदी पात्राच्या बाजूला पाझर तलाव बांधून चरे करण्यात आले. यामुळे आता आसपासच्या गावातील पाणी पातळी वाढली. भूजल पुनर्भरण झाले आणि गावाच्या पीक पद्धतीत बदल झाला. पूर्वी ४० किलो क्विंटल कांद्यावरून गाव आता ३५० क्लिंटल कांदा पीक घेते. तर ८० एकर असणाऱ्या गव्हाचे क्षेत्र ३०० एकरवर पोचले. ग्रामपंचायतीच्या विहिरीची पाणी पातळी वाढली.

पाझर तलावा पाणीसाठा बाष्पीभवनामुळे वाया जावू नये म्हणून गावकऱ्यांच्या मागणीप्रमाणे रोटरीने नदी आणि तलावाच्या बाजूला जलधारा प्रकल्प राबवला. जैवविविधता जपण्यासाठी देशी झाडांची लागवड करताना जिमनीत पाणी साठवून ठेवणारी आणि जिमनीचा कस वाढवणाऱ्या झाडांची यात निवड झाली. या प्रकल्पाच्या निमित्ताने शहर आणि गाव यातले अंतर कमी होण्यास सुरुवात झाली. केवळ शेती नव्हे, तर जलसंधारण कामाने गावातील महिला मोठ्या संख्येने एकत्र आल्या. शेतीशी संबंधित व्यवसाय विशेषतः कुक्कुटपालनसारखा प्रकल्प महिला राबवत आहे. रोटरीने ग्रामस्थांना कौतुकाची थाप दिली आणि मराठवाडा ग्रामीण विकास संस्थेलाही बळ मिळाले.


ROTARY MEGA JOB FARE

16-June 2024

Though many of the government schools provide basic amenities, their conditions are not up to the mark. They lack proper infrastructure, facilities and a good learning environment. Most of the students come from economically weak backgrounds. The school does not charge any tuition fees. Lack of financial resources is the most significant challenge that prevents such schools from undertaking infrastructure upgradation on their own. The schools rely on Government aid and the generosity of donors to address these challenges. However, continuing paucity of funds over long periods has been leading to severe degradation in quality of education. As a consequence of this, the students lack willingness, motivation and interest in learning. To transform such schools into finer schools of higher quality, our club undertook a project called as "ROTARY KI PATHSHALA" under the advocacy of Rotary International District (RID) 3132 and Rotary India Literacy Mission (RILM). RID 3132 provided our club cupboards and books to establish libraries in some schools located in remote villages. To strengthen the infrastructure in schools further, we decided to focus our attention and efforts on upgrading the schools by providing them furniture and equipment. Besides support from District Grant, our club also got support from Ratna Nidh Foundation and CSR funds from Kalika Steel Jalna to make the schools happier. Ratna Nidhi Foundation provided library cupboards for 14 schools. Kalika Steel Jalna provided library cupboards for 10 schools through their CSR funds. On 16th June 2024, library cupboards, books and other furniture were dedicated to schools by club President Rtn Rustum Tupe. Project chairman Rtn Uddhav Shirsat guided the students and school staff about the proper utilization of the facilities provided by our club. Many of the Rotarians and people from village were present on this occasion.
