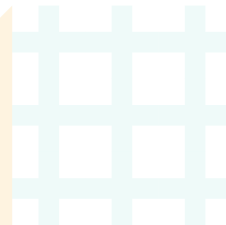

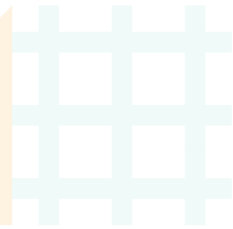

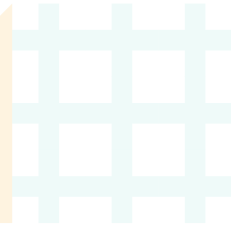
1. Purchase of a 190 - Liter Refrigerator for Rs. 11499 (including transport charges of Rs. 600).

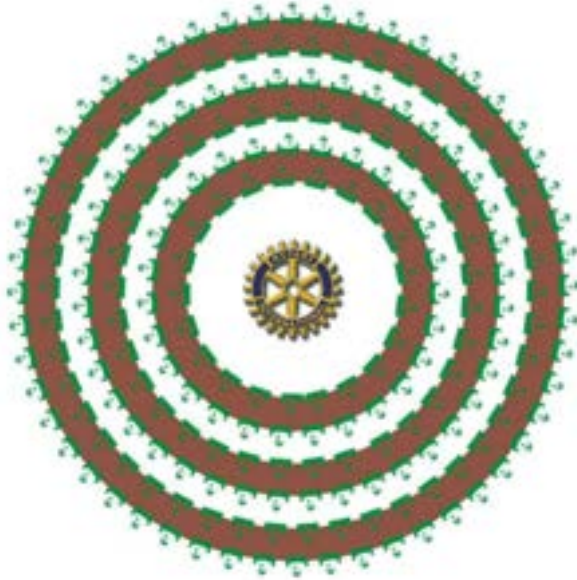

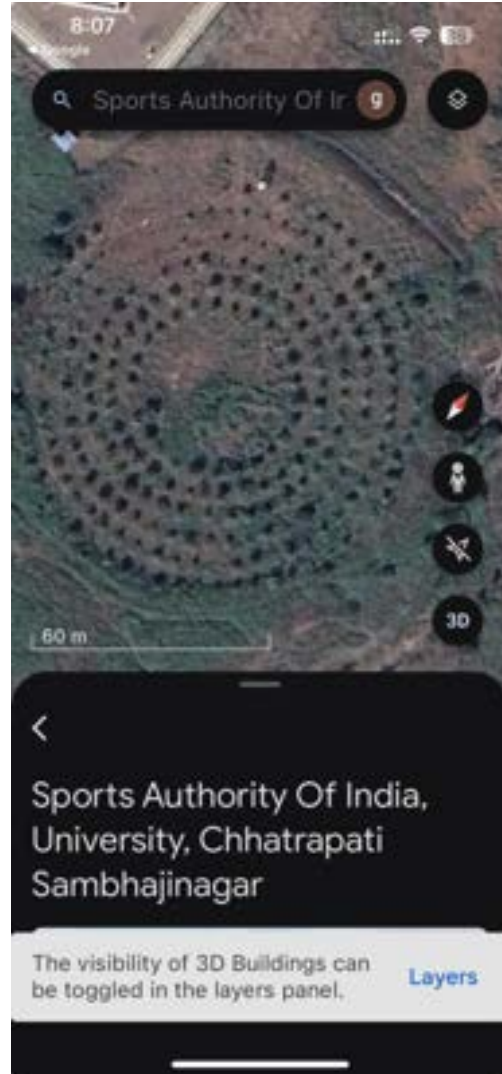
# **Rotary Green Wheel** **Walking Plaza, Sports** **Authority of India, Aurangabad**

जून महिन्यात वटपौर्णिमेनिमित्त "या युगाची आधुनिक सावित्री" विषयावर ऑनलाइन ग्रूप तर्फे आयोजित निबंध स्पर्धेत माझ्या निबंधाला द्वितीय क्रमांकाचे पारितोषिक मिळाले. या युगाची आधुनिक सावित्री स्पर्धक- डॉ. शिल्पा आसेगावकर प्राध्यापक शासकीय वैद्यकीय महाविद्यालय छत्रपती संभाजीनगर. पुरातन काळात सत्यवानाचे प्राण वाचवणारी सावित्री, स्वातंत्र्यपूर्व काळातील स्त्रियांना शिक्षणाची कवाडे उघडून देणारी क्रांतीज्योती सावित्री, आधुनिक युगातील सर्व क्षेत्र पादक्रांत करणारी सावित्री..... तिघींच्याही व्यक्तिमत्त्वांमध्ये कालपरत्वे अंतरबाह्य बदल आढळून येतात. आपल्या पूर्वीच्या सावित्रींचे कार्यक्षेत्र चूलमुल ह्या पुरतेच मर्यादित होते. पण त्या काळातील स्त्रियांनी एकत्र कुटुंब पद्धतीच्या संस्कृतीचा खूप मोठा ठेवा जतन केला होता. पूर्णतः पतीवर अवलंबून असलेली सावित्री स्वतःसाठी जगतच नव्हती. फार कमी स्त्रियांना शिक्षणाची संधी मिळायची. त्यांच्यावरील अन्यायाला, अत्याचाराला वाचा फोडली ती सावित्रीबाई फुलेंनी आणि स्त्रियांचे व पर्यायाने कुटुंबाचे, समाजाचे व राष्ट्राचे विश्वच बदलले. त्यानंतर अनेक समाजसुधारकांनी महिलांच्या प्रगतीसाठी प्रयत्न केले आणि आता बऱ्याच अंशी महिलांचे सक्षमीकरण झाले आहे. "स्वावलंबनाचा उद्योग प्रपंच | ज्ञानधन संचकरी यत्ने ||"





ह्या सावित्रीबाईंच्या काव्यपंक्तीनुसार स्त्री शिक्षणामुळे स्वतंत्र व स्वावलंबी झाली. आधुनिक युगातील सावित्री तर आर्थिक दृष्ट्या सुद्धा आत्मनिर्भर झालेली आहे. तिचे कार्यक्षेत्र घरापुरतेच मर्यादित न राहता विविध क्षेत्रात भरीव कामगिरी करत आहे. कुटुंबातील प्रत्येक जबाबदारी पतीच्या खांद्याला खांदा लावून समर्थपणे पेलत आहे. मुलांचे संगोपन व त्यांचे शिक्षण ह्यात तर सगळ्यात मोठे योगदान हे आईचेच असते. "जिच्या हाती पाळण्याची दोरी ती जगाला उद्धारी" या उक्तीप्रमाणे पुढच्या पिढीला घडवण्याचे काम आजची सावित्री करत आहे.

सत्यवानाच्या सावित्रीने मरणाच्या दारातून पतीला वापस आणले, त्याचा जीव वाचवला. त्याचप्रमाणे शिक्षणाची जोड मिळाल्यामुळे आधुनिक सावित्री संपूर्ण कुटुंबाचा सांभाळ जीव ओतून करत आहे. कित्येक सावित्री तर स्वतःचे अवयव उदाहरणार्थ किडनी यकृत पतीला दान करून त्याचे प्राण वाचवतात. पण आता ह्या पाश्चात्त्यीकरणाच्या काळात आधुनिक सावित्रींनी आपल्या पुरातन सावित्रीच्या शिकवणीला विसरता कामा नये. आधुनिकपणा सिद्ध करण्यासाठी स्वैराचार, बेदरकारपणा, उद्धटपणा, व्यसनाधीनता ह्या गोष्टींपासून कटाक्षाने दूर राहिले पाहिजे. उलट अजूनही समाजातील ज्या महिला शिक्षणापासून वंचित आहेत, ज्यांच्यावर अन्याय, अत्याचार होत आहेत अशा महिलांना आपल्या सोबत घेऊन त्यांचे आयुष्य घडवण्याचा प्रयत्न केला पाहिजे. आधुनिक युगातील सावित्रीने संस्काराची शिदोरी पुढील पिढीकडे सुपूर्द केली तर आपल्याला आदर्श राष्ट्र निर्मितीकडे वाटचाल करता येईल व आपल्या भारतातील सावित्रीच्या बुद्धिमत्तेचा, चातुर्याचा, कर्तृत्वाचा ठसा नक्कीच जगाच्या नकाशावर उमटल्याशिवाय राहणार नाही.

# **Mário César Martins de Camargo of Brazil selected to be Rotary International President for 2025-26**

Mário César Martins de Camargo, a member of the Rotary Club of Santo André, São Paulo, Brazil, is the selection of Nominating Committee for President to become Rotary International's president for 2025-26. He will officially become the nominee on 15 September if no other candidates challenge him.

De Camargo plans to boost Rotary's public image by working from the top down.

"Rotary today has strong competition for members and funds," he says. "We need to rejuvenate the brand, especially in some zones. We should utilize post-pandemic meeting tools ... to allow the president to address Rotarians all over the globe. We also need to develop more long-term partnerships with political, community, and business leaders. Let's emphasize our greatest asset: 1.4 million volunteers."

He also hopes to improve Rotary's process for appointments and governance.

"Rotary should adopt a more transparent system to appoint volunteers for positions, with clear criteria and data-based evaluation of results," he says.

De Camargo was president of Gráfica Bandeirantes and has been a consultant to the print industry in Brazil. He has also served as president and chair of several printing and graphics trade associations, including the Brazilian Association of Graphic Technology and ABIGRAF, the Brazilian Printing Industry Association.

He has served on the board of Casa da Esperança (House of Hope), a hospital sponsored by his Rotary club that serves 150,000 children with disabilities every year.

De Camargo studied in the U.S. and Germany and holds degrees from EAESP-Fundação Getulio Vargas in business administration and Faculdade de Direito de São Bernardo do Campo in law. He was a Youth Exchange participant to Minnesota, USA, in 1974-75, which inspired a lifelong commitment to the program.

A Rotarian since 1980, de Camargo served as his club's Youth Exchange Officer in 1981, at age 24. He has served Rotary as director, trustee, RI learning facilitator, committee member and chair, and task force member.

De Camargo and his wife, Denise, are Major Donors and Benefactors of The Rotary Foundation.
