

Excellent session by Mr. Nilesh Surana on the topic EGO to ECO

Mr. Nilesh Surana's session on the transition from "EGO to ECO" was an excellent and thought-provoking exploration of the fundamental shift that is needed in our individual and collective mindsets. He eloquently unpacked how the pervasive ego-driven mentality that pervades modern society is at the root of so many of the pressing environmental, social, and economic challenges we face today. By moving from an egocentric worldview focused on self-interest, greed, and the relentless pursuit of material wealth, to an ecocentric perspective that prioritizes harmony with nature, cooperation, and sustainable stewardship of our shared resources, we can unlock the pathway to a more balanced, equitable, and regenerative future.

Mr. Surana provided a compelling framework for this inner transformation, highlighting how the ego-fueled by insecurity, attachment, and the constant need for validation - drives us to engage in destructive behaviors that degrade the planet and divide humanity. In contrast, an "ECO" mind set

cultivates a profound sense of interconnectedness, gratitude, and reverence for the delicate web of life that sustains us all. Through mindfulness practices, systems thinking, and a deep reconnection to our natural environment, he demonstrated how each of us can take tangible steps to transcend the limiting confines of the ego and become active co-creators of a thriving, regenerative "ECOsystem" - one that meets the needs of people and planet in balance.



Women Empowerment 9 days events in association with Anandi Foundation






