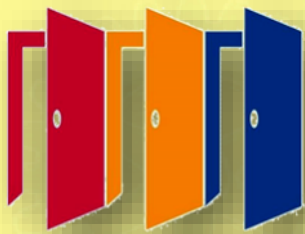

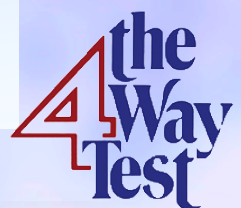

# TRF CONTRIBUTIONS IN 2019-20 SURPASSES PREVIOUS YEAR

The 2019-20 Rotary year was unlike any other because of COVID-19. However, we adapted, joined together in new ways, and were reminded of why we originally joined Rotary. Amid the challenges, our Foundation enabled Rotarians to continue serving their communities in a time of great need. For example, our polio infrastructure was used to detect the coronavirus, and The Rotary Foundation awarded hundreds of district grants, global grants, and disaster response grants to combat it.

Rotarians continued to give generously to our Foundation to help meet these increased needs, and I am delighted to share the news that **more than \$408.6 million (unaudited) was raised in 2019-20**. This amount surpasses our \$400 million comprehensive goal. In addition, we reached the \$50 million PolioPlus goal for outright contributions, District Designated Funds, and resulting World Fund matches. These accomplishments were made possible by the strong support of leaders like you.



You are among the first to receive this news about last year's fundraising total. More detailed reports with specific information on regions and funds will be available soon. Other communications will also be shared more broadly, including a special thank-you video that will be emailed to all 2019-20 supporters this month. Audited numbers will be available in November.

Thank you, once again, for all you do and for your incredible support of our Foundation.

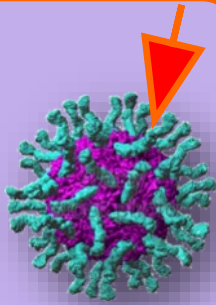
