It's extremely sad that most of these deaths occur due to easily preventable causes such as malnutrition, diarrhoea and pneumonia. It's important that we have a robust health system in place that ensures good health for children and expectant mothers. Several NGOs have been working across India to improve the current health status of newborns, mothers and pregnant women. These programs lay focus on the disadvantaged communities that often suffer the most due to these social evils.

Some of the key programmes are the Janani Surakha Yojna, Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana, Village Health and Nutrition Days, Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakaram, Wage Compensation scheme for pregnant women (in some states), Weekly Iron Folic acid Supplementation, and Poshan Abhiyan.

In Rotary April month being dedicated to Maternal and child Health we Rotarians can contribute to this social cause by spreading the message to the general public by giving information about the various programs referred above. For spreading this message, Rotarians need not spent much. Creating awareness about the various program will help the needy in overcoming malnutrition and maintaining good health.



"Bring a bundle of grass, because we have an ass in the room," the teacher orders a front bencher.


'And for me a coffee!", the student added.
