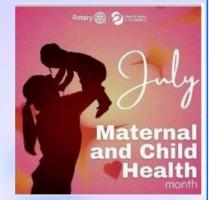


Mother and Child Health-The Role of Rotary

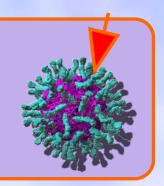
