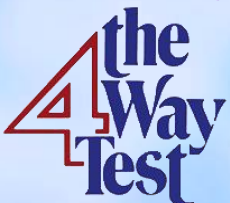

Providing financial literacy

Rotary members help people learn about financial management and banking systems.

Providing equipment

Rotary members provide people with equipment to help them start businesses.

Improving access to financial services

Rotary members partner with local microlenders to improve access to financial services.

Improving soil fertility

Rotary members help farmers improve soil fertility and control soil erosion to increase crop yields and profits.

Helping weavers

Rotary members help Indian weavers achieve better wages and working conditions.

The structure of Rptary

The structure of Rotary International is made up of clubs, districts, zones, and Rotary International itself:

Rotary clubs

The core of Rotary, clubs are made up of members who come together to build relationships, exchange ideas, and take action. Rotary clubs are non-political, non-religious, and open to all people.

Districts

Rotary clubs are grouped into districts to make local administration easier. Each district has a district governor who leads a team of assistant governors and district committees. The district governor's role is to support and strengthen clubs, and motivate them to carry out service projects.

Zones

Rotary International is divided into 34 zones, each with a similar number of Rotarians. Each pair of zones elects a director to serve on the Rotary International Board of Directors.

Rotary International

The global association that supports Rotary clubs worldwide by coordinating global programs, campaigns, and initiatives. The Rotary International organization is led by the RI president and the RI Board of Directors.
