Rotary members are encouraged to recognize the worthiness of all occupations and to dignify their own occupations as opportunities to serve society. [2, 3]

Contribute professional expertise

Rotarians are encouraged to use their professional expertise and skills to address community problems and needs. [1, 2]

Some examples of Vocational Service activities include: [4, 5]

Mini-classifications talks

Each member gives a five-minute talk about their vocation to promote vocational awareness. [5]

Vocational awards

Present a vocational award to someone in the community who has exemplified outstanding professional achievement. [5]

Career guidance workshops

Organize workshops to provide career information to youth or mentor small businesses. [4, 5]

Ethics workshops

Invite an ethics speaker to speak at a club meeting or partner with the local Chamber of Commerce to put together an ethics workshop. $[\underline{4}, \underline{5}]$

Rotary Skillshare series

Have club members present on their professions to help other members learn from their expertise. [4]
