Rotary Club of Calcutta started its Mega Project of 50 EYE Check up Camps in this Rotary Year 2024-25 with a target of 10000 beneficiaries.



In these camps, EYE Check ups will be done

with distribution of Free Spectacles with power and Cataract operations will be done.

The first camp was inaugurated by our President Rtn. Subrata De by lighting of the Lamp and he was accompanied by Rtn. Ravindra Khandelwal Community Chair, Rtn. Arindam Roy Chowdhury (Special Projects Chair) and

Rtn. Ruchika Majumder and spouse Surendranath Majumdar. The camp was operated by Kataganj Ramkrishna Vivekandanda Seva Samity (KRVSS). The club launched this project on Doctors Day, in honour of Late Dr. B.C. Roy.



The camp covered 210 beneficiaries out of which 164 beneficiaries i.e. 78% need spectacles, 14 were detected for IOL and Cataract Surgeries, i.e. 6% and others were detected with no problem. The club will arrange the surgeries within two months in an EYE Hospital.

Vision for All - 2nd Eye Camp

Rotary Club of Calcutta continues its Mega Project of 50 camps for EYE Check-up in the Rotary year 2024-25.

In these camps, EYE Check-ups will be done with distribution of Free powered Spectacles and Cataract operations will be done. The second eye check-up camp has been conducted on 7th July, 2024.

The camp covered 202 beneficiaries out of which 103 beneficiaries will need spectacles. 26 were detected for IOL and Cataract Surgeries. Others were detected with no problem. The club will arrange the surgeries within two months in an eye hospital.

2. Spectacles 103 units @ Rs 800 each: Rs. 82400.00
