Rotary Club of Calcutta continues its Mega Project of 50 camps for EYE Check-up in the Rotary year 2024-25. In these camps, EYE Check-ups will be done with distribution of Free powered Spectacles along with Cataract operations. These camps are conducted as per SOP, and beneficiaries are identified for correction by spectacles or surgery, and the processes are thoroughly explained to them. For spectacles, they are directed to the spectacle desk and contact details of those requiring surgery are noted for follow up. Rotary branding is prominently put. In total, 498 beneficiaries were screened in the 3 camps, of which 304 required spectacle correction and 84 required surgical correction. The beneficiaries and the RCC Stars expressed their gratitude to the Rotarians attending, they were delighted with the presence of





Rtn. Atin Sen who despite travelling all night long, made it to the eye camp project at Stars. They require support from the club for which details have been sought to channelize through literacy and health committees.

were found requiring Phaco eye surgery, out of which 10 patients have availed free eye surgery on 29th August.

All beneficiaries received positive postoperative reports, with no complications detected. They have been given comprehensive guidance on post-operative care, provided with free eye drops from the hospital, and their first post-operative check-up was also free. The beneficiaries and their households expressed satisfaction with the services and commended

PRANDHARA Phase 1 – Water filter distribution -12/09/2024 at Rotary Sadan – AOS Community; AOF Providing clean water, sanitation, and hygiene



Clean drinking water is still a luxury for many underprivileged members of our society even in 2024. Many schools still don't have the basic infrastructure to provide safe drinking water to children, who are the leaders of tomorrow. To ensure the hygienic water infrastructure, Community service committee of Rotary Club of Calcutta took up the cause and continued the project of water filter donation to schools to bridge the gap.



District Governor AKS Dr. Krishnendu Gupta along with PDG Rajendra Khandelwal, PDG Angshuman Bandopadhyay, PDG Mukul Sinha, PDG Rajani Mukherji, PDG Raju Rajgaria, PDG Ajay Agarwal graced the occasion of Pranadhara Phase 1 and handed over certificates and water filters to 49 clubs of District 3291. PPs Abhijit Kolay, Heena Gorsia, Raj Agrawal, Kanak Dutt, Secretary Suman, PE Debnath and 10 Rotarians attended the event. This project was done through collaboration with 49 clubs of District 3291. Appeal letters from all clubs were accepted so that the monitoring and implementation of the project can be done in a structured manner. The committee aims to distribute 46 more water filters in Phase-2 to schools of Howrah in the month of October/November 2024.

5 quotations for water filters were taken. Livpure, being the cheapest and renowned brand, was chosen. We acquired machines at Rs. 6040 each directly from the company. The funds of this project were claimed from the interest of four endowment funds i.e. Shubhakarangini Devi Nahata endowment fund, Chapala Rani & Bhupendranath Dey endowment fund, Rural sanitation and Community Service endowment fund and Dr. Nandita Sen & Biswajit Sen Diamond Anniversary endowment fund. 31 individual members also donated towards this project.
