I visited the Rotary Club of Bombay at the Grand Ballroom of Taj Mahal Palace hotel, Mumbai on the 15th of October, at a luncheon meet. I felt privileged to represent the old number one from District 3291 and conveyed the greetings on behalf of President and members of our Club and exchanged flags with President Satyan Israni. The Rotary Club of Bombay is 9 years younger than us, chartered in March, 1929. I also met some lovely Rotarians and enjoyed the talk by Boman Irani, (not the actor but Founder of Rustomji Group). Overall, a very pleasing experience.

Trek Report by Ajay Agarwal



A 6000 m (approx 20k ft) peak is not an unfamiliar territory for me. However, it does become daunting when one is one the wrong side of 60's and has been welcomed into the Senior Citizens club. Then there are friends /wellwishers / doctors warning you to 'act your age' and not to take unnecessary risks and hazards. The concerns are not out of place. To address them one needs to work harder and be better prepared.

The dream of a '6000 m at 60' was conceived about a year ago. The preparation was begun for that one night when one would be climbing and descending 3-3.5k ft in one go, a journey of 12-15 hrs, braving low oxygen conditions, subzero temperatures and icy cold winds.

DzoJongo Peak is located in the beautiful Zanskar region of Ladakh. Standing tall at an altitude of 6,240m (20,472 ft), this peak offers a challenging climb and stunning views of the surrounding valleys and mountains. The trek takes one through picturesque villages, remote landscapes, and pristine alpine meadows.

DzoJongo was visible as one of the snow capped peaks in the pictures I took from the flight to Leh. Over the next few days, we went over 2 high mountain passes, the

Shiulpass at 5100 m and the Chak pass at 5500 m, to reach the Base Camp at 5200 m. An acclimatisation day at the basecamp and then the much awaited climb to the summit. The sunrise over the vast horizon, the touch of red and gold over the snowclad peaks and the landscape were a sight to behold.

The return involved a climb through another mountain pass, the KongmaruLa from where one enters the valley of the Rainbow Mountains. It's a 10km walk through very scenic and colourful mountain landscape. It ends at Chokdo village and marks the return to network, electricity and civilisation.
