Clean drinking water is still a luxury for many underprivileged members of our society even in 2024. Many schools still don't have the basic infrastructure to provide safe drinking water to children who are the leaders of tomorrow. To ensure hygienic water infrastructure, Community Service committee of Rotary Club of Calcutta took up the cause and continued the project of water filter donation to schools to bridge the gap.

We welcomed all schools and explained the schools to put up signboards on the wall next to the water purifier highlighting the name of Rotary Club of Calcutta Welfare Trust and Bengal Beverages Pvt. Ltd. These signboards have been supplied by BBPL. Shri Jaydev Mukherjee, GM of BBPL (Bottler of Coca Cola) attended the event on our invitation and handed over the purifiers to the schools' representatives in person. He addressed the gathering by emphasizing the impact of BBPL's CSR initiatives. President Subrata De addressed the gathering and spoke about Rotary Club of Calcutta's initiative on water sanitation. 
