









Ninety-Eight years ago a sunshine project was initiated, which has ever since become a source of joy to underprivileged and orphaned children. In 1925 a programme of entertainment of the underprivileged children was conceived by the Rotary Club of Calcutta. It received the immediate approval of all Rotarians and more so of their Annes, who with zest and enthusiasm took active part in its execution. It started on 28 December, 1925. Some 200 poor children from 5 institutions in Calcutta were collected by Rotarians and their wives, driven to the Chandpal jetty and taken across the river to the Botanical Gardens. A day of feasting and sports ensued. At the end of the day the children were driven back to their orphanage. Thus, the longest running Community Service programme of the Club was born, the famed Annual Children's Treat. The tradition continues. Over the years the number of children has increased, the institutions have changed but the format of the programme and more importantly the spirit behind it has remained the same. In the 1970s the Annual Children's Treat was held at the beautiful and spacious lawns of the National Library, Belvedere, Alipore and thereafter shifted to the Command Hospital Ground, Alipore. Since 1993 the Treat has been held at Nicco Park, Salt Lake,

This year the 99th Annual Children's Treat was organized on Sunday, the 8th December, 2024 at Nicco Park, Jheel Meel, Salt Lake City, Kolkata-700091. About 1200 children from 22 institutions and RCCs participated in this whole day event. The programme was inaugurated by Lt. Commander Renu Ramdurg of the Indian Navy. Our thanks to Rtn. Sarvani Gooptu for initiating her presence as the Special Guest.

In the morning at 6.00 a.m., 19 buses arranged by Rtns. Saswati Mukherjee, Shampa Ghosh, Sarvani Gooptu and Anand Sharma picked up about 800 children from 17 Institutions located in and around Kolkata and took them to Nicco Park for a Day of Sunshine, Fun and Frolic. Breakfast and Fruit juice were served to the children in the buses and on their arrival at Nicco Park they were served with glass of hot drink. Another 400 children from our 5 RCCs joined the programme by coming straight to Nicco Park from their respective centers. After the inaugural programme at 10.00 a.m. the children proceeded to the park area to enjoy the rides. At about 1.30 p.m. the children assembled for lunch which were served to them

hamper was presented to each participating child.

The end of the day saw a 1 200 strong band of children leaving for their home — tired but happy. Thus ended a day of sunshine as has happened for the last 99 years, with a glow in the hearts of the receivers and more so in the hearts of the many givers who made this day possible, waiting one more year for **A Day of Sunshine**. The spirit has remained the same as





it was envisioned 99 years ago in December, 1925.
