

Anuvab Pal 'The Dangers Of Making People Laugh'



Anuvab Pal, hailed by The New York Times as "India's Most Intelligent Comedian" and The Guardian as "very brilliant, very funny," has performed his hit stand-up special The Nation Wants To Know over 1,000 times across 30 cities worldwide, including sold-out shows in Sydney, San Francisco, and Singapore. He is the only Indian comedian to perform at Harvard University and for the Prime Ministers of India and Great Britain. A prolific writer, Anuvab has created cult classics like Loins of Punjab Presents and The President Is Coming and penned Bollywood hits such as Baar Baar Dekho, Hichki, and Bhoot Police. His play Chaos Theory was a finalist for the BBC World Service Radio Playwriting Award and featured on Broadway. He has also written a sitcom starring British comedy legend Stephen Fry for BBC Radio 2. His BBC show The Empire,





viewed by 6 million globally, is now a permanent exhibit at the V&A Museum. Anuvab's latest acting roles include Freedom at Midnight and A Suitable Boy. He features in a thriller called Pune Highway, that premiered at The Indian Film Festival in Goa.

Fundamentals of AI & IoT: A Hands-on Workshop held on Dec. 13, 2024 at Rotary Sadan: AOS New Generations









On December 13, 2024, the Rotary Club of Calcutta, along with the Rotary Clubs of Inner City and Presidency, hosted a workshop on "Fundamentals of AI & IoT" at Rotary Sadan. Aimed at providing hands-on learning, the event featured 48 students (classes VIII–XII) and 10 teachers from 8 Kolkata schools. The workshop included interactive sessions on AI, machine learning, and IoT fundamentals, followed by practical exercises in building supervised ML models and IoT setups using virtual platforms. Highlights included a sensor-operated





miniature car demonstration. Instructional materials, 25 hired laptops, and Alliance Broadband's 500 Mbps Wi-Fi ensured smooth execution. Rtn. Dr. Saswati Mukherjee and Prof. Dr. Susovan Jana led the sessions, supported by Jadavpur University scholars. The event began with the national anthem and inspiring addresses by district officials. Participants received certificates, and the workshop earned enthusiastic feedback, marking it as a resounding success. The workshop began with the national anthem, led by Interactors, and was moderated by Rtn. Pradip Gooptu. Rtn. Subrata De addressed the audience, while Rtn. Yogesh Dassani and Rtn. Ruchika Majumdar honoured dignitaries with uttoriyos. President of the two co-collaborating clubs Rtn. Tunir Chakravarty, and Rtn. Abha Lunia were present, as were District Officials delivered inspiring speeches. Several Rotarians including PP Raj Agrawal and PE Debnath Chattopadhyay were present.
