In January 2025, the Interact Club of Asian International School launched a program aimed at teaching basic Math, English, and the Bengali alphabet to their house helpers. Throughout the month, they successfully engaged in this initiative, and their students now possess a good understanding of





counting and speaking in English. India faces significant challenges with literacy rates, which inhibit development. Many NGOs have taken action to combat illiteracy by providing free vocational education and establishing schools. The initiative by the Interact Club of Asian International School has made a meaningful impact on individuals living below the poverty line who lack fundamental literacy skills. It has been observed that most elderly people living below the poverty line are devoid of any literacy.

Rotary Club of Calcutta continues its Mega Project of 50 eye camps for eye Checkup in the Rotary year 2024-25. In these camps,

eyecheck-ups are done with distribution of free powered spectacles along with cataract operations, if required. These camps are conducted as per SOP, and beneficiaries are identified for correction by spectacles or surgery, and the processes are thoroughly explained to them. For spectacles, they are directed to the spectacle desk and contact details of those requiring surgery are noted for follow-up. Rotary branding is prominently put. In total, 429 beneficiaries were screened in both the camps, of which 308 required spectacle correction and 37 required surgical correction. **Total Project Value is :**
