

Rotary Club of Calcutta continues its Mega Project of 50 eye camps in the Rotary year 2024-25. In these camps, eye check-ups are done with distribution of free powered spectacles along with cataract operations, if required. These camps are conducted as per SOP, and beneficiaries are identified for correction by spectacles or surgery, and the processes are thoroughly explained to them. For spectacles, they are directed to the spectacle desk and contact details of those requiring surgery are noted for follow-up. Rotary branding is prominently displayed. In total, 467 beneficiaries were screened in both the camps, of which 266 required spectacle correction and 53 required surgical correction.
