Barkha Dutt, Senior Journalist

Barkha Dutt is an award-winning TV journalist, anchor and columnist with more than two decades of reporting experience. She is India's only Emmy-nominated journalist who has won multiple national and international awards, including the Padmashri, which is India's fourth highest civilian honour.

Barkha graduated from St. Stephen's College, Delhi with a degree in English Literature. She did her Master's in Journalism from the Graduate School of Journalism at Columbia University in New York.

Barkha has reported from some of the toughest



spots and conflict zones in India and across the world including Pakistan, Iraq, Afghanistan, Libya and Egypt. Her frontline reporting of the Kargil war first made her a household name.

She is an out spoken feminist voice on the global stage and also the Founder-Editor of Mojo, a multi-media events and content venture. She is also the founder of 'We the Women', a multi-city festival and current affairs website that focuses on the biggest gender debates of our time.

She is a featured Columnist with Washington Post; appears regularly as an analyst on CNN and BBC and is also a Contributing Editor at The Week magazine.

Anuvab Pal- Stand up, comedian, novelist & scriptwriter

The New York Times calls Anuvab Pal India's most intelligent comedian. The BBC calls him India's answer to British wit. NDTV calls him 'a comic genius'. His stand up comedy specials The Nation Wants To Know and The Empire have had over 500 shows started in Mumbai and played to sold out audiences worldwide. They've been called "Spectacular" by CNN and "incredibly clever' by The Guardian. He's also the only Indian comedian invited to perform at Harvard University and for the Prime Ministers of both India and Great Britain. Times of India list him among India's top 5 English comedians and his stand up performance for the BBC titled Empire, has been seen by 6 million people worldwide and part of the permanent collection at Victoria and Albert Museum in London. As a scriptwriter, he's the author of 2 Bollywood films and 2 web series now playing on Amazon Prime.
