Rakshit Tandon, Cyber Security Expert

Rakshit Tandon, Cyber Security Evangelist, has experience of more than a decade in Security Domain chairing and being part of various Important Security Councils and Chapter. He is Cyber Security Consultant to Internet and Mobile Association of India.

He is marked as Resource Person/Faculty for Cyber Crime Investigations at BPRD Bureau of Police Research And Development for Training Law Enforcement Officers across the Country and is Member Advisory to National Cyber Safety and Security Standards.



He, in personal capacity, has sensitized more than 2.5 million students on the issue of Cyber Safety across the nation covering more than 26 states, 4 union territories and played important role contributing to Child Online Protection in India Report by UNICEF. Tandon was Non-European Expert at European Commission on Safer Internet in 2010.

Tandon was awarded with Karamveer Chakra by Rex Conclave 2015 and in 2016 with Gold Karamveer Chakra. He won the Cyber Guru of the Year Award in 2015 from Government of Maharashtra. He has been invited to national and international conferences on Cyber Security as Key Note Speaker and Panelist.

He served as faculty to major Police academies across the country like CBI academy, NEPA, CDTS Ghaziabad-Chandigarh-Jaipur, PRTS Indore etc and has conducted sessions with Australian Embassy, European Union Delegation to India, United Nations Department of Safety and Security (UNDSS), UN WFO, CII, FICCI etc.

On a cold & foggy winter morning on 26th Jan, 2021, RC Calcutta celebrated Republic Day in a conventional manner by raising the National Flag, with Boys' Scout volunteers doing a ceremonial salute to the flag, and NCLCL students signing the National Anthem. DG Sudip Mukherjee accompanied by President Debashis Mitra hoisted the Flag, witnessed by Club members, numbers limited to permissible limits in line with statutory Covid Pandemic restrictions.



# **NICCO Park**









On account of Covid Pandemic and prevailing restrictions on public gathering, this year's Children's Treat was organised in a very novel & unique split location basis and yet in simultaneous manner, both timing & content-wise. Whereas the conventional NICCO Park remained the central gathering but restricted to 200 participants only, 6 RCCs simultaneously organised the 'Children's Day out' in their respective localities, with uniform program meticulously co-ordinated by Children's Treat Committee, chaired by PP Abhijit Kolay. At Nicco Park DG Sudip Mukherjee inaugurated the program, with President Debashis Mitra along with a host of club members overseered a day of fun & frolic, games & joy rides, a magic show, interspaced with food & snacks and a sumptuous lunch, home cooked at Rotary Sadan kitchen and served lovingly by fellow Rotarians. The participants were city based school children only, transported in 6 buses arranged by RC Calcutta, all wearing identification badges, face-mask & Rotary caps, received the usual gift hamper inside logo embossed back packs at conclusion of day's outing, while respective school escorts and team of Roteractors ensured continuous vigil in social distancing regulations and pandemic norms of frequent hand sanitisation.

A Puppet Show was arranged at 6.00 PM for 'adults' where children were also welcome but only if accompanied by adult parent/guardians. The participants aggregating to 110 nos, were given tiffin, lunch cooked at site, and a Hi snacks at 3.00 PM before Magic show. Apart from face masks, Rotary caps and identification badges, all were given gift hamper in Rotary logo embossed back packs. The Rotarians overseered some of the events, handed over the prizes and accompanying certificates to the winners, gladly helped in serving lunch to the participants, and ceremonially handed over some gift hampers before departing.
