Dr. Lakshmi Vijayakumar, Psychiatrist

Dr. Lakshmi Vijayakumar is the founder of SNEHA, an NGO in Chennai for the prevention of suicide. She is the Head, Department of Psychiatry, Voluntary Health Services, Adyar, Chennai. She is a member of the W.H.O's International Network for Suicide Research and Prevention. She is an Honorary Associate Professor in the University of Melbourne, Australia and Hon Adjunct Professor, University of Griffith, Australia.

She has been conferred Honorary Fellowship of the Royal College of Psychiatrists (FRCPsych), U.K. for her work on suicide prevention and also has been conferred FRCP (EDIN), She was awarded the Ringel Service award by IASP in June 2015.

She has published widely in peer reviewed journals and has authored several chapters and edited two books.

A team from R C Calcutta led by President Dr. Debashis Mitra, representing the Healthcare Committee, donated certain essential hospital equipment to Humanity Hospital, Hanspukur, in Thakurpukur at a ceremony on 26<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2020. The donations were entirely funded by Rtn Arindam Roychoudhury, under the banner of Project Surama, a trust founded in the fond memory of his grandmother. Mr Subhankar Kar, hospital Superintendent, received the gift on behalf of the hospital. The ceremony was attended by R C Calcutta officials including President Mitra, Hony Secy. Bodhi Brata Das, IPP Purnendu Roychoudhury, Prez Elect Sujata Pyne, PP Abhijit Kolay, Rtn. Atindra Nath Sen, Hony. Treasurer Ashok Basu and Rtn. Amit Ghosh.

Humanity Hospital is a Multi Speciality hospital, founded in 1996, under a Trust formed by Dr Ajoy Kumar Mistry and his mother Padmashri Subasini Mistry, a lady of meagre & humble origin. Dr Mistry, Chairman & Managing Trustee of Humanity Trust, has nurtured the hospital to its current 45 bed facility at Hanspukur, with a 25 bed branch in Gosaba, South 24 Parganas. Humanity's Vision Statement includes "Free treatment for the needy, expanding to remote places in true spirit of service to humanity". Humanity Hospital is currently a listed Covid-19 hospital declared by Govt. of West Bengal, and the hospitals both at Hanspukur and Gosaba, and all its facilities of ICU, ventilator support, Infection control programs, are dedicated for treatment of Covid patients.

The equipment package donated to Humanity Hospital includes:

3 Fowler Beds 2 Saline stands

3 Mattresses 1 Bed-side table

1 Examination Bed 1 Food trolley

1 Wheel chair

The gift was gracefully received by Mr Kar, Superintendent, Humanity Hospital. He, on behalf of Dr Ajoy Mistry, conveyed his deep gratitude. The

equipment reached Humanity Hospital on the same day, was 'unpacked', and 'put to use' for patient care immediately.





## Rezang fa Battle - Fortunate Insight

When 123 Indian soldiers faced impossible odds against 3000 well-armed Chinese and fought to the last man.

On a freezing and unforgiving November night, 123 Indian Soldiers - frost bitten, weary, hungry and heavily outnumbered – defied the might of the rampaging Chinese army. On November 18, 1962, Major Shaitan Singh and men of Charlie Company, 13 Kumaon Regiment, forever passed into the mists of legends. Responsibility to defend Chushul in Ladakh fell on the small force of 123 army men eventually in course of the battle.

Unfortunately, this Company had no suitable winter clothing and they were under armed and unprotected and to add to the already impossible situation, Charlie Company was "Crested to artillery". This meant that there was an intervening feature, which did not allow Charlie Company the cover and protection of Indian armies' artillery.

Heavily armed Chinese army attacked them with full force and might. The platoon, true to their training, held

their fire till the last moment. When the Chinese were a mere 90 meters away, the platoon opened up with all their weapons. The fire was devastating and hundreds of Chinese dead bodies littered the "nullahs". The second wave of the Chinese army was repulsed.

Major Shaitan Singh moved from platoon to platoon, firing at the enemy and encouraging his men. He ignored the grave danger to his life and kept fighting.

Thereafter, under severe attack of large Chinese force, Kumaon Regiment ran out of ammunitions and they fought

with their bare hands. Naik Ram Singh, a wrestler, killed many Chinese soldiers with his bare hands before he was shot in the head. They repulsed seven attacks by the Chinese.

After cease fire on November 21, 1962 when Indian army visited Charlie Company location, Major Shaitan Singh was found holding his weapon meaning he had died fighting. The nursing assistant was found dead with bandages and a syringe in his hand. The Mortar section commander was found dead holding a mortar round. Out of the thousand mortar rounds that Charlie Company had, all but seven had been fired.

Indian army also found that the soldiers faced the enemy and took the hail of bullets to the chest and none of them was hit on the back as none of them retreated.

Major Shaiitan Singh Bhati was posthumously awarded Paramvir Chakra, the highest recognition. The Company was also awarded eight Vir Chakras and four Sena Medals. Charlie Company was later re-designated as Rezang La Company.

Most of the above information is in public domain. I was very fortunate to have an insight to this later. On November 18, 1979, we were in Ranikhet, the headquarters of Kumaon Regiment, in a guest house located within the army cantonment zone. We attended the commemoration of Rezang La Battle Day deep inside the hills with




enacting of the fights. There were stories of extreme bravery narrated by very senior army men. The best we got to learn that there were Chinese flags laid by the side of each corpse as a sign of highest respect. We felt overwhelmed and feel all Indians should know this.
