Women's fquality

Two related external stimuli have motivated this piece. One: listening to a program titled "Women's Equality Day" (Aug 26) and two: reading article themed experiences of women with disabilities in Odisha, in the education area. Here's a summary within the bounds of Samiran's 'Box', an attempt to spotlight gender based exclusion.

Women with disabilities face discrimination in education, healthcare and employment. There is also a high prevalence of abuse in this group. However, the necessity of having some sort of education is ingrained because they are continuously told "there is no one to provide for you". In education settings, they are often victims of attitudinal bias leading to bullying and violence. In one anecdote, a girl seeking admission for a degree course who had missed the published deadline was 'helped' by the peon of the institution for a 'fee'. The central government has legislated the Persons With Disability Act 1995, and The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Bill 2016 has been introduced. Quoting the author: "Media depictions of disability are slowly undergoing a change...but these are exceptions in the sea of stereotypical images of disability".

Outside of legislation, the role of the community is emphasized. Presently counselling is directed only at the concerned child, often to enable her to come to terms with her disability. De-stigmatizing and support counselling need to extend to the family, the school, the ecosystem of doctors, and rehabilitation professionals.
