- At ICAI, National and International Forums, he took sessions and seminars on 23+ topics

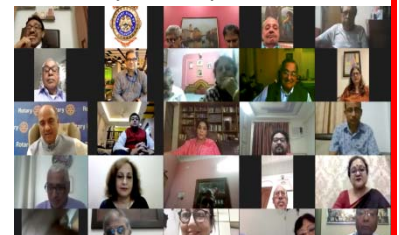
He has been covered by a coffee table book and recognized as "Young India Visionary" by IMG innovative Media Group in whole of UAE.
