


Chief Guest Hon'ble Sh Justice Biswanath Somadder



Born on December 15, 1963, Justice Biswanath Somadder obtained his B.A. and LL.B. degrees from the University of Calcutta. He also completed a Certificate Course on Office Automation Tools under the Computer Education Programme of the Regional Computer Centre, Calcutta. He was enrolled as an Advocate on July 21, 1989, and practised in the High Court at Calcutta as well as in the Supreme Court of India. He also regularly appeared before the CESTAT, Eastern Regional Bench. His areas of practice included Constitutional Law (with special emphasis on matters relating to Customs & Central Excise, FERA, Telecommunications, Education, Service, and Income Tax), Arbitration, Company Law, Revenue, Civil, and Criminal Law. He specialised in Revenue,





Arbitration, and Constitutional Laws. He served as Senior Counsel for the Central Government in the High Court at Calcutta and was the Honorary Joint Secretary of the Bar Library Club of the Calcutta High Court, until shortly before his elevation to the Bench. Justice Somadder was elevated as a permanent Judge of the High Court at Calcutta on June 22, 2006. He was appointed Executive Chairman of the West Bengal State Legal Services Authority by the Governor of West Bengal through notification dated November 5, 2018. He also served as Judge-in-Charge of the Administrative Department, High Court at Calcutta, with effect from November 19, 2018, discharging functions assigned under the Appellate Side Rules of the High Court. He held the position of Acting Chief Justice of the Calcutta High Court from January 1, 2019 to April 3, 2019. He was transferred to the Allahabad High Court, where he assumed charge as a Judge on October 17, 2019. Subsequently, he was elevated as Chief Justice of the High Court of Meghalaya and took oath on April 27, 2020. Thereafter, he was transferred to the High Court of Sikkim, where he took oath as Chief Justice on October 12, 2021.




