Patti Hoffman Consul General of USA

Ms. Patti Hoffman assumed the post of Consul General of the United States of America for the Kolkata Consular District on August 3, 2018. The Kolkata Consular District includes West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand, Sikkim, and the seven northeastern states.

Immediately prior to coming to Kolkata, Consul General Hoffman was a student at the National War College at the National Defense University (NDU) in Washington, DC. Previously, she served as Chief of Staff to the Director General of the U.S. Foreign Service and Director of Human Resources. Ms. Hoffman has served overseas at the U.S. Embassy Mexico City, U.S. Embassy London, U.S. Embassy Quito, and U.S. Consulate General Rio de Janeiro. Ms. Hoffman has also served in several positions at the U.S. Department of State in Washington, DC.

Consul General Hoffman is originally from the Philadelphia area.

Shekhar Mehta is only the 4th Indian in 115 years to be nominated as the President of Rotary International for the year 2021-22.

Shekhar Mehta was born in 1959 in Kolkata India. A keen academician, he graduated from St. Xavier's College, has the unique and combination of Masters in Commerce, a gualified Chartered Accountant, Cost Accountant and Company Secretary.

He heads the Skyline Group engaged in Real Estate Development in different parts of India, including the largest group housing in the state of Rajasthan.

He served as District Governor in 1999-2000 and was elevated to the Directors of Board of Rotarv International for 2011-2013. While serving as Rotary International Director, he helped Rotary add 2 countries to its fold - Bhutan & Maldives. Keenly dedicated to service, Mr. Mehta has led many major service initiatives in India.

To build a stronger membership, Knaack says Rotary must focus on increasing the number of female members and transitioning Rotaractors into Rotarians.

Knaack believes that the People of Action campaign offers new public awareness possibilities for Rotary. "This campaign conveys our global image while still respecting differences in regions and cultures," he says.

A Rotary member since 1992, Knaack has served Rotary as treasurer, director, moderator, member and chair of several committees, representative for the Council on Legislation, zone coordinator, training leader, and district governor.

He is an endowment/major gifts adviser and co-chair of the Host Organization Committee for the 2019 Rotary International Convention in Hamburg.

Knaack is the CEO of Knaack KG, a real estate company. He was previously a partner and general manager of Knaack Enterprises, a 125-year-old family business.

He is a founding member of the Civic Foundation of the City of Ratzeburg and served as president of the Golf-Club Gut Grambek. Knaack is also the founder and chair of the Karl Adam Foundation.



DOCTOR'S DAY - 1ST JULY

"SANKALPA" – BLOOD DONATION DRIVE

Rotary Club of Calcutta co-hosted District 3291's Blood Donation Drive – commemoration of Doctor's Day. The Blood Donation Drive was organized



simultaneously at three locations, viz Rotary Prakash Bhawan, Saroj Gupta Cancer Hospital and Rotary Sadan. Dr. Krishnendu Gupta oversaw the Rotary Sadan Camp, inaugurating it at 9.00 AM. The District visualising that a big majority of Rotary Club members would be restricted from donating blood, either on account of age

bar (60+ years) and/or on account of health ground (BP/Diabetes/Hypertension), had arranged collaboration with Rotaract Clubs, and Rotaractors came in large numbers for blood donation. All necessary medical regulations were compiled with before the donor could donate blood, and all COVID precautions were strictly adhered to while donating blood (sanitizing, touch, mask, distance).

President Debashis Mitra escorted DG Sudip Mukherjee and PDG Anshuman Bandopadhyay to the Camp and addressed the gathering. DG emphasised the need for blood for critical patients like thalassemia, and PDG Anshuman congratulated all donors for their humanitarian service. The camp recorded about 75 donors for blood. Camp finished at 1.00 pm.

PANEL DISCUSSION: LIFE IN THE TIME OF COVID 19

A virtual panel discussion was organised by the Club on the occasion of Doctors' Day on the very topical subject of Covid 19 with particular reference to the progression of the pandemic in India and the impact of the virus on the school children and their incarcerated life. The panelists were:



Dr. Rivu Basu, Community Medicine Specialist; Dr Arun Kr Manglik, Pediatrician; Dr Pallab Chatterjee, Pediatric Surgeon; PP Dr Ashok Kr Basu and Rtn Dr Debashis Mitra (see poster).

Dr Basu enlightened the participants about the spread of the virus in India and the effect it had by the stringent lockdown. His explanation that the lockdown was meant to delay the peaking of cases and not to flatten the curve was most revealing. Dr Manglik and Dr Mitra expressed their views about how and when to restart the schools, the message being: the safety of the children as well as the elderly at home should at the centre of such a decision. Dr Pallab Chatterjee spoke the precautions (PPE) that are essential while dealing children undergoing surgery. PP Dr Asoke Basu highlighted the upside of the lockdown quipping on

how his health and family bonding had improved during lockdown.

The discussion was most engagingly moderated by our own Rtn. Dr Sandip Chatterjee in his own inimitable manner. The virtual meeting was ably hosted by Rtn. Arindam Roychoudhury.
