A Diabetic Retinopathy unit at Priyamvada Birla Aurobindo Eye Hospital was

inaugurated on 1 Nov 2023. It is a Global Grant Project of the Club. The total Cost of the project



is approx Rs 70 Lakhs. This was a culmination of yearlong work last year to arrange the funds including DDF allocation from the District and to get the Global grant approved. It was to be completed in June 2023, but due to formalities at the foreign club, it got delayed. But it is worth the efforts as we now have an equipment which will be hugely beneficial to the community.

service), catering to marginalised rural poor, OT but no Wards since Day Care primarily, treatment for Glaucoma, Cataract, Retina in addition to vision testing. DG expressed the need for Global Grant for "diagnostic vehicle" with equipment to deliver "Doorstep Eye Care" in rural areas. This got a favourable response from the members of the visiting clubs from Britain. Saumen Ray assured to take matter forward. After a walk-through of

the hospital premises, an elaborate lunch was offered with DG personally serving. Before departing, the British team members-Brian, David & Mary, Dr Swapan-expressed thanks & deep gratitude to DG for the opportunity to witness how "Service to Community" is delivered in Rotary District 3291.

Chair Special Projects Arindam has sent out a teaser - "As Samarth 1 is coming again this year in December, venue will be updated soon, our President today sponsored the full 375 wheelchairs. This year it will be a gathering of more than 1000 nos. Two Mega Shows. Children's Treat then Samarth 1 Mela. Please volunteer for the Mela."

PP Saumen Ray reports - On 30 Oct, Mayor Firhad Hakim, Santanu Sen MP, 4 British Rotary Clubs, 2 RCCs, some 15 members of Rotary Clubs, another 15 Rotarians from from District 3291, RID Anirudhha Roychowdhury, Interactors totalling nearly 50 participated in the Ganga Abhiyan boat trip from Outram Ghat to Dakshineswar and Bally visiting 12 Ghats, our District 3291 pilot project, led by our club. The Mayor said the government projects haven't had many successes because of poor implementation. He supports and looks forward to Rotary's initiative for Pilot implementation at 12 ghats. In answering the media, the mayor said "we support and assist Rotary in this initiative, and we like Rotary's approach to implementation". He asked us to submit our detailed plan which RID supported. RID wishes to extend the project to other Districts.

On 3 Nov, Brian Johnson, David Johnson, Mary Johnson, Gill de Warren, Dr Debnath, Yogesh, Amit, and Saumen Ray visited Sundarbans. They visited Sarberia School, David distributed chocolates. An eye camp was organised by Priyamvada at Sarberia Hospital. They also visited Rangabelia Hospital and identified need for solar lights to save Rs 40,000 a month electricity charge. A need was felt for a simple school global grant next year at Rangabelia hospital.

The team is now headed for Ayodhya to showcase our Ayodhya Pahar School. Collated from WA posts..
