Hira Lal Yadav joined Rotary Club of Hooghly in the year 1995. He served as the President of the Rotary Club of Hooghly in the year 1998-1999 & 1999-2000. He is a past Rotaractor. He graduated from Calcutta University. He is a Plywood Manufacturer.

He revived the sick club which was recommended to be closed by the then District Governor. He established Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital in the year 2000 with only eight members in a rented building. The Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital became so popular that a more spacious building was required. He constructed a well-designed 3 storied building for Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital in the year 2013. Now, Rotary



Hooghly Eye Hospital is a complete Eye Care Centre and pride of Rotary District 3291. In the last two decades he has helped eighteen clubs in India and two clubs in Bangladesh to establish Eye Hospitals. He is the Chairman of Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital, Rotary Gangadharpur Eye Hospital & Kuchaikot Rotary Eye Hospital-Bihar. He is also the Chief advisor/Technical Advisor of 17 Rotary Eye Hospitals.

Presently 55000-60000 surgeries are being done in these Eye Hospitals & 4 lakhs to 4.50 lakhs patients are being treated in the OPD & in Out Reach camps. His dream is to arrange Eye Check-up for 10 lac patients & eye surgeries for 1 lakh patients.

He has served Rotary District 3291 in different capacities and was invited as Guest Speaker in the Training Sessions and Conferences of Rotary District 3250 & 3291.

He is a great supporter of "The Rotary Foundation" & was instrumental in successfully completing 82 Global Grant Projects for different Rotary Clubs in India, Bangladesh, Singapore & UK. He had made arrangements to construct many tube-wells to provide safe drinking water in the remote villages of Hooghly. He also gave new life to 27 needy children by arranging Heart Surgeries in R. N.

JHULAN GOSWAMI

Jhulan Goswami, who really needs no introduction, was born on November 25, 1982, in Chakdah, West Bengal, and is a former Indian cricketer known for her exceptional bowling skills. She played for the Indian women's cricket team from 2002 to 2022 as a right-arm medium-fast bowler and right-handed batter. Goswami made her international debut at the age of 19 and went on to achieve numerous milestones in her career.

Goswami is recognized as one of the fastest female bowlers of all time and is considered one of the greatest bowlers in the sport. She played 204 one-day international (ODI) matches and holds the record for the most wickets in women's ODI cricket, with 255 wickets to her name. She retired from international cricket in 2022 after a successful career.

Throughout her career, Goswami received several accolades, including the ICC Women's Player of the Year award in 2007. She also captained the Indian women's cricket team from 2008 to 2011 and led the team to their first Test series win in England in 2006-07. Goswami was honoured with the Arjuna Award in 2010 and the Padma Shri in 2012 for her contributions to cricket.

Goswami's story will be brought to life in the biopic "Chakdah Xpress", directed by Prosit Roy and starring Anushka Sharma. The film, set to premiere on Netflix, will showcase her inspiring journey and accomplishments in the world of cricket.

ROTARY INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT GORDON MCINALLY PROFILE



R. Gordon R. McInally is President of Rotary International. He was educated at the Royal High School in Edinburgh and at the University of Dundee, where he earned his graduate degree in dental surgery. He operated his own dental practice in Edinburgh until 2016. Gordon was chair of the East of Scotland branch of the British Paedodontic Society and has held various academic positions. He has also served as a presbytery elder, chair of the Queensferry parish congregational board, and commissioner to the general assembly of the Church of Scotland.

Gordon joined Rotary in 1984 at age 26. A member of the Rotary Club of South Queensferry, he has served as president and vice president of Rotary International in Great Britain and Ireland (RIBI). He has also served

RI as a director and on several committees, including as an adviser to the 2022 Houston Convention Committee and chair of the Operations Review Committee.

Gordon says he looks forward to working with members to build new Rotary clubs and groups. “My vision is that Rotary should exist everywhere in a style to suit everyone who has the desire to be part of us and to help us do good in the world,” he says.

Gordon is a patron of the UK-based nonprofit Hope and Homes for Children and led a partnership between that organization and RIBI to support children in Rwanda who had been orphaned in the genocide there. He is a patron of Trade-Aid, an initiative of the Rotary Club of Grantham Kesteven, Lincolnshire, England, that provides sustainable humanitarian aid to individuals, families, and businesses in the developing world. He is also an ambassador for Bipolar UK, a national mental health organization.

In his free time, Gordon enjoys rugby, good food and wine, and stick dressing, the traditional Scottish craft of making walking sticks.

Gordon describes The Rotary Foundation as “the fuel that provides the energy to do Rotary service.” He and his spouse, Heather, also a Rotarian, are Paul Harris Fellows, Major Donors, and Benefactors of The Rotary Foundation. They are also members of the Bequest Society.

Gordon wishes to dedicate his presidency to making the world a better place for his granddaughters, Ivy, and Florence, to live and thrive.

PROFILE OF PRESIDENT KANAK DUTT



A Johuree par excellence, a brand builder, a philanthropist, a keen learner and a veteran Rotarian, Kanak Dutt is the able grandson of famous Bengali businessman and freedom fighter Benud Behari Dutt, who contributed towards India's nationalism by successfully surpassing highly competitive jewellers of the British period and winning several awards for his acumen.

Kanak Dutt, the Managing Director of Benud Behari Dutt Pvt Ltd and Senior Partner of Benud Behari Dutt, followed his grandfather's footsteps from an early age of 18 and took over the leadership of the Gold & Diamond business, carrying forward its goodwill and legacy.

A self-made man Kanak Dutt has several feathers on his hat. He was appointed and empanelled as Jewellery Valuer and Appraiser by the

Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) and Directorate of Revenue and Intelligence (DRI) and Customs, Govt. of India in 1988. He is also a reputed consultant of precious stones and diamonds.

He has been an active Rotarian since his induction in 1977. In RY 1989-90, Rotary Club of Calcutta, formed a Trust named after his grandfather and handed over a sick Rotary health centre to him. In association with Benud Behari Dutt Trust, Kanak soon transformed it into a successful Health Clinic that served innumerable underprivileged patients with support from fellow Rotarian doctors and other professionals for almost two decades.

He successfully celebrated the Centenary year of Benud Behari Dutt Jewellers in 1982, at an event where many dignitaries including the then Union Finance Minister Pranab Mukherjee joined the inaugural session.

Kanak Dutt has been felicitated by the All India Football Federation for conceptualising, designing and manufacturing the Jawaharlal Nehru Invitation International Gold Cup in 1984, the Bridge Federation of India for designing and manufacturing the memento of International Bridge Tournament for their silver jubilee. He was recognized and honoured by the Cricket Association of Bengal (CAB) for awarding the Indian and West Indies cricket team during the Test Match under the captainship of Nawab of Pataudi. Bengal National Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BNCCI) in association with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) also felicitated him for his contribution towards the skill training of 300 artisans.

A philanthropist, Kanak Dutt believes in Service Above Self and through several Trusts that he has created, pledges his devotion and dedication towards social service. A man of positive thoughts and beliefs, he has furthered the cause of Rotary by becoming a Major Donor.

Kanak Dutt is a veteran member of Calcutta Club since 1985, Bengal National Chamber of Commerce and Industry and Calcutta Police Club.
