Shikha is the Founder and President of India Prader Willi Syndrome Association (IPWSA) which supports member families in their efforts to improve the quality of life for all Indian people with Prader-Willi Syndrome by improving physical and mental wellbeing, socially as well as occupationally. The Prader-Willi syndrome is the most commonly known genetic cause of lifethreatening obesity in children. The incidence rate of Prader-Willi syndrome is estimated to be 1 in 15000. The genes lacking in people with PWS have a major role in the regulation of appetite and metabolic levels, cognitive functions, and behaviour patterns,

She is also a committee member of the Organisation of Rare Diseases, India (ORDI) which is a national umbrella organization





representing the collective voice of all patients with rare diseases in India. She is a Director of Bengal Rare Warriors Association.

A full comprehensive Topcon Specular Microscope with Computer System with monitor and Table was installed at the Eye OPD of the Hospital. Another Pantacame Corneal Topography Machine with License Key was installed in the Eye OPD which will help the Therapeutic treatment for Cornea patients. As this Hospital is in Behala, a lot of patients from entire South 24 Parganas will get the benefits from the Eye department of the hospital. The department is supported by renowned Eye Surgeons of Kolkata who do dedicated service to the hospital. This hospital has two buildings with 150 beds, CT Scan, X Ray, and USG with Pharmacy.

RC Calcutta is grateful to Cera Sanitaryware Ltd., P.P. Vikram Somany and the Koya family for supporting this project. The project value is Rs 16 Lakhs. Total beneficiaries will be around 1000 patients per month with a total of 12000 patients per year.
