GHAT CLEANING: 3 Ganga Ghats – 12 Jan 2024 : AOS Community; AOF Environment

A Ghat Cleaning event, part of the 'mega' Ganga Abhiyan project, was organized collaboratively by WASH, Ganga Abhiyan, and Youth Services Committees, involving 7 Interact Clubs. The initiative aimed to instill community responsibility in Interactors, going beyond cleaning to create lasting awareness. 77 Interactors from seven clubs joined hands to clean 3 Ganga Ghats. Led by PP Saumen Ray, the total assembly surpassed 100 participants. President Kanak Dutt, unable to attend, conveyed his best wishes through Saumen for the project's success. Hony. Secretary Sarvani, PPs Abhijit Kolay and Raj Agrawal, PE Subrata De and VP Debnath Chattopadhyay, Chair Youth Saswati, Co-Chairs Wash and Ganga Abhiyan, Sonia and Partha, Club Correspondent Amit, Rtn Promita Saha, Rtn Ruchika, Rtn Udit Mitra graced the occasion. The presence of PDG Rajani and Rtn. Apala Dutta, RC Avyanna and DICC Dist. 3291 enhanced the occasion. RC Benevolence with their Interact Club, RC Universe and the local councillor were present.

Saumen introduced the day's project as a precursor to the mega Ganga Abhiyan Project, focusing on garbage cleaning and removal as a pillar, along with public awareness for the Clean Ganga Initiative. Three chosen ghats included Champatala Ghat (200 years old, refurbished by RC Calcutta including thematic wall painting), Nandibari Ghat (100 years old), and Kumartuli Ghat (over 300 years old) with average user footfall of 800 (winter) to 1200 (summer). Saswati welcomed the gathering on the day that marks Swami Vivekananda's 161st birthday and National Youth Day. The 7 Interact clubs (viz. Asian International School, Vidyanjali High School, Silver Point School, Sailendra Sircar Vidyalaya, DPS Howrah, Serampore Girls' High School and Birla Bharati School) were introduced, and Interactors were split into 3 groups for the designated ghats with Teacher Coordinators, each led by a Rotarian supervisor. The teams used pre-arranged tools for cleaning and disposed the collected garbage only at municipal bins at ghat entry points.

Interactors, driven by enthusiasm for community service, traded textbooks for trash bags, making a positive impact on the sacred ghats. River Police on speedboats, advised caution due to High Tide, and Partha leading the Disaster Management team ensured safe working conditions. Saumen Ray invited senior Rotarians to share their views post-program. Abhijit Kolay highlighted the project's positive impact on river pollution. Rajani Mukerji had Interactors share their ghat cleaning experience on National Youth Day. Subrata De, delivering the vote of thanks, thanked the municipal, port and police authorities and all who attended. Saswati coordinated creative performances by Interactors, featuring recitation, enactment, and dance. Post-performance, Sarvani and others distributed certificates to the Interactors, followed by snacks as a token of appreciation.

Key takeaways from the ghat cleaning project for the 'mega' Ganga Abhiyan project : (i) Repaired and refurbished ghats attract three times more bathers. (ii) A floating garbage trap is vital to prevent garbage from escaping, aiding in river water cleanliness and bather safety during tides. (iii) Lack of women's toilet facilities and covered dressing/changing areas is a pressing need. The public address system engaged the community, showcasing project specifics to the satisfaction of those who witnessed the Champatala Ghat renovation in the previous year.

Sailendra Sircar Vidyalaya


