## Kodály-inspired Workshop January 18 2024 : AOS - New Generation; AOF — Supporting Education

On January 18th, 2024, the Youth Service Committee, organized an activity-oriented Kodály-Inspired Musical Workshop at Rotary Sadan. The workshop aimed to demonstrate the benefits of activity-based music education, including providing a scientific and sequential approach to learning music, comprehending information faster through engaging and enjoyable music lessons, improving concentration and fostering a positive attitude, reducing stress and anxiety, and improving coordination. A total of 129 students from classes VIII to XII and 42 teachers from 21 Bengali medium schools in Kolkata and its suburbs participated in this workshop. The event was a remarkable success, with enthusiastic participation. All participants received participation certificates. The program began with the national anthem followed by a welcome speech from Rtn. Dr. Saswati Mukherjee, Chair, Youth Services Committee. The Club President, Rtn. Kanak Dutt, addressed the audience, followed by a brief speech by PP Rtn Heena Gorsia, PDG Rajani Mukherjee, and Rtn. Hirak Ray. The workshop concluded with a vote of thanks by Rtn Debjani Ghosh. ## 2nd Club Assembly 21 Jan. 2024: AOS - Club

President Kanak Dutt, assisted by Hony. Secretary Sarvani Gooptu, convened the 2nd Club Assembly for the Rotary Year 2023-24, held at Rotary Sadan on 21st January, 2024 at 10 am. Around 20 Rotarians including Committee Chairpersons, Co-Chairpersons, Past Presidents, and Green Badgers attended the event.

NCLCL, Cultural Section and Computer Centre - Chairperson - Roshni Ganguly discussed the continuous upkeep of Library material, organisation of the cultural centre classes and conducting of the Computer and Spoken English Exams under NIELIT with official Certificate distribution. Cultural Section in charge Parama's tenure has been made permanent and salaries have been revised for other staff. The Children of the Cultural Section presented impressive programs on Independence Day and for Agomoni.

Community Service, RCC and Vocational Service - Chairperson Yogesh Dassani discussed Project Pranadhara-2, Clothes Distribution during Durga Puja in which importantly all the clothes were made by our own RCCs at Ranihati and Joygram. Rtn Yogesh thanked Rtns Arindam, Purnendu and Sujata for helping in organising material for the clothes. BYJUS Learning APP were distributed to 10 schools for 250 beneficiaries and Chair thanked donor Sonia Dutt.

Youth services update: Dr. Saswati Mukherjee reported on the program "Meeting the Challenges of Peace in the VUCA World" in which 48 children participated, and Conclave and Essay Contest on "Empowering Girls and Amplifying their Voices," involving nine Interact Clubs from RC Calcutta and Innercity. Three new Interact Clubs were inducted: Sailendra Sircar Vidyalaya, Serampore Girls' High School, and Calcutta Boys' School. The initiative aimed to foster community responsibility and create lasting memories. Additionally, a Kodály-Inspired Musical Workshop showcased the benefits of activity-based music education at Rotary Sadan. The Youth Services Committee also collaborated with Wash and Ganga Abhiyan, Special Projects, and Children's Treat, with significant Interactor participation.

Membership update: Chairperson Rtn. Anusua Das reported 7 new member inductions and 11 resignations. Emphasis was placed on proposing quality members, with discussions on retention and engagement. A 2-minute talk by Green Badgers has been started to increase engagement. The Chairperson urged proposers and seconders to be involved in candidates' participation, suggesting mandatory attendance for the first 3 months to boost involvement. Highlighting Green Badgers' project attendance in The Chaka and weekly meetings was proposed to encourage their continued engagement.

Programme Committee Chair Rtn Satarupa Ghosh Mukherjee reported that a galaxy of speakers has been invited for RWMs in the afternoon as well as at least 1 RWM in the evening with fellowship. In the second quarter, in the month of October 2023 we had a cultural program celebrating the festivals of Autumn and an Antakshari program with participation by our members and Rotary Anns. On 1st January 2024 we celebrated the 105th Charter Day where Prof. Sugata Bose came as the guest speaker. We also had live music performance on the lawns followed by fellowship n dinner.

Women's Empowerment - Chairperson - Shampa Ghose – reported a seminar on International Girl Child Day, on 'Empowering Girls' with special emphasis on Child Rights and Child Protection, followed by a panel discussion on Child Rights and Child Protection. The ongoing project with girls of Ektara NGO in collaboration with brand Prahnaaya, which is an international fashion brand, has garnered a lot of attention and praise from people and is reporting incomes Rs 8-10,000 per month. A similar initiative is underway with an NGO formed by girls of Calcutta Girls School. An initiative with Knexup aims at empowerment by leveraging domain expertise.

Special projects update: Chairperson Arindam Roychowdhury highlighted the success of Samarth Mela 1, including the distribution of 385 wheelchairs to individuals with disabilities and 835 school shoes to underprivileged children. A total of Rs 74,28,000/- was spent, with plans to repeat the event annually. Donors for the project include President Kanak Dutt, Rtn Shampa Ghose, CYP Purnendu Roychowdhury, PP Sujata Pyne, Rtn Abhijit Kolay, and Rtn Saurabh Khemani. Progress on the Rotary Blood Bank (HMC Rotary Centre) was showcased, with completed electrical, CCTV, partition room, false ceiling, and plumbing work. Rotarians were updated through visual presentations.

Health Care Committee report: In the absence of Chair Ayusmati, the Honorary Secretary presented the report. Children's Day on November 14th was marked by gifts and health check-ups for orphaned children at Samparc Home, with regular six-month check-ups conducted by Dr. Thakur. A Police Health Screening at Rotary Sadan served around 30 police officers. On World Disability Day, a vocational project was inaugurated at Deep Ranjani Foundation for lupus and acid attack survivors, and sewing machines and computers donated by Rtn Souryaveer Himatsingka and organized by CSR Chairperson, PP Rtn Sujata Pyne was distributed. An Adult Immunization Camp's second phase at Rotary Sadan administered vaccines to approximately 20 individuals for disease prevention.

Following the Health Committee presentation, Rtn Amit Ghosh commended the recent projects and camps and reflected on some of the past endeavours including cross-border cancer awareness programs, equitable treatment for paediatric patients from Bangladesh, paediatric surgery camps for underprivileged children, comprehensive thalassemia mapping, and eye camps under the Prevention of Blindness Campaign. He stressed the need for sustained efforts and follow-up spanning over a year or more for such initiatives. He supplied copies of Chaka write-ups outlining these cases to the President for review.

Wash and Ganga Abhiyan update: Chairperson Saumen Ray reported the completion of WASH 3 at RCC Duttapukur, with

plans to expand the project scope using saved funds. WASH 4 in Birbhum completed, while WASH 5 in Dara RCC chapter is complete, Krishnanagar RCC Chapter is underway, and the Birbhum chapter has begun. The Ganga Abhiyan saw a successful foreign team visit, identifying international partner clubs, with public support from Mayor Firhad Hakim. A joint interact program for ghat cleanliness was organized by the Youth Service committee. The Priyamvada Birla Diabetic Retinopathy Global Grant project is awaiting MOU finalization. The club has been invited to the London Peace Conference in February, showing interest in their Kashmir/Ladakh projects. Additionally, two Rotary Clubs from Brisbane and Adelaide, Australia, have been inducted into CCRC. Four committee meetings were held throughout the year, with minutes submitted to the Honorary Secretary.

Annual Children's Treat update: Chairperson Abhijit Kolay's report, presented by Rtn Yogesh Dassani, detailed the event held on December 10th, 2023, at Nicco Park, Salt Lake, Kolkata, with 1200 children from 22 institutions and RCCs attending. Lt. General R.P. Kalita GOC-in-C Eastern Command was the Chief Guest, with a Military Band adding to the attraction. Approximately 50 Rotarians, their spouses, 40 Interactors & Teacher Coordinators, and 200 escorts and support staff were also present. Transportation was facilitated by 25 buses, including 18 from sponsored Interact schools, providing breakfast, lunch, ice cream, soft drinks, and health drinks to the children, along with gift bags and caps. Total expenses amounted to Rs. 10.36 lakhs, with Rs. 4.92 lakhs in cash donations and Rs. 5.44 lakhs contributed by the Rotary Children's Welfare Trust. He highlighted challenges faced, suggesting the need for increased member contributions to meet rising costs and considering reducing the number of participating children due to difficulties in securing free school buses.

Strategy: Chair Udit Mitra reported on the survey findings in which 48 members have given their responses. More responses are expected.

Green Badger Tapan Basu shared his thoughts on attending the Club Assembly and was impressed by all the work that was going on in Rotary Club of Calcutta.

President thanked all members for making it convenient to attend this important meeting and whole heartedly congratulated all committees for taking up important projects. The meeting was adjourned by President wishing all to be the inspiration and the absolute best for a great Rotary year 2023-24.
