Sanhati RYLA – Co Hosted by Rotary Club of Calcutta : AOS - New Generations

Sanhati RYLA for tribal youth was organized at Nayagram, Kharikhamathani in Nayagram Thana Balika Vidyapeeth on 2, 3 and 4 February, 2024. This is a signature project of RC Calcutta Samaritans, and for this edition, RC Calcutta co-hosted the event. A total 50 young tribal girls of age between 12 to 16 years attended the camp. The camp was framed with various sessions covering (i) Ethics of Positive Leadership, (ii) Fundamentals of Leadership, (iii) Problem solving and Conflict Management, (iv) Importance of Communication Skill in Leadership, (v) Building of Self Confidence and Self Esteem, (vi) the Role of Rotary in community development and various activities during the three days' camp. DG Hira Lal Yadav inaugurated the program – there was a march past, a dance recital, and the traditional lighting of the lamp.



PDG Shyamasree Sen, DGND Tapas Bhattacharya, among others, conducted the sessions in the above-mentioned topics. Notably all these children are totally





deprived from these exposures in the normal course and hence this type of youth activities really gives a great impetus to personal development.
