

Rotary Oration on World Understanding and Peace Day – Dr. Kunal Sarker Peace for Health – AOS Club

The Rotary Club of Calcutta observed World Understanding and Peace Day on 23rd February with the Oration Day lecture delivered by one of the leading cardiac surgeons of India, Dr. Kunal Sarkar. To ensure that the spotlight is equally focused on peace and health, he chose the topic of "Peace for Health" drawn from the WHO's initiative which highlights the need to promote peace and health to protect the world and its people. Peace enables good health and vice versa. Dr. Sarkar helped his audience understand the background to this and the emergence of a new threat with an increase in cardio- vascular and other lifestyle diseases once the Second World War had ended. This was an era when Horlicks and smoking was considered to be good for health and hence the rise in smoking related heart diseases such as heart attacks and heart failure.

He successfully managed to weave in enriching stories of those whose research and inventions led to better diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of heart diseases such as Christian Doppler in Salzburg whose principle of Doppler effect is used in echocardiography. There was also Reno

Favoloro, an Argentine cardio surgeon who pioneered the life saving coronary bypass surgery. Dr. Sarkar shared another courageous story of how Dr. Christiaan Barnard dared the first human to human heart transplant in South Africa, a historical event and major breakthrough in medical science. What made it even more remarkable was that the heart of a black man was given to a white man at the height of Apartheid in South Africa. We also learnt about the indispensable importance of Islamic Science to the world of science and medicine. Whilst heart diseases is the leading cause for mortality in India, there is a silver lining as life expectancy has now increased to 70 years which is only 7 years behind the US. Dr Sarkar shared advice and guidance on how we can improve our heart health for example a healthy diet, maintaining a healthy weight and regular exercise.

The overarching message to the audience was that health and peace are interdependent therefore the two must work together if we are to build a resilient, equitable and healthy society.

Workshop – Empowering with Experiential Knowledge – AOS – New Generations


The Women's Empowerment Committee organised a workshop on 'Empowering with Experiential Knowledge' on 17th of February at 11 am at Rotary Sadan. Around 40 students and professors and Rotarians participated in the event. The speaker was Ms Soma Basu, Cofounder of Knexup. The panel included two other industry experts Mr Kaushik Ghosh and Mr Sugato Banerji. The program started with opening remarks by Chairperson Women's Empowerment Committee, Rtn Shampa Ghose followed by introduction of the speaker by Co chair Rtn Debjani Ghosh. President Rotary Club of Calcutta, Rtn Kanak Dutta motivated the girls with his inspiring words. The session then started with Ms Soma Basu explaining how Knexup, a unique concept which believes that the high value experiential knowledge of domain experts should not be lost.

Experiential knowledge is not available to individuals in an easily accessible and organised form. Women (students and early career individuals) struggle during their learning journey and at the initial stages of their career because they don't have access to experiential knowledge of experts which can make them industry ready. This hampers their learning and performance outcomes. Knexup is an inclusive content and networking platform for domain experts and educators to showcase their experiential knowledge and for individuals to access and use this, through multiple channels of engagement and networking. In addition to academic knowledge, educators have a vast amount of experiential knowledge which they are not always able to deliver within a structured curriculum. Knexup's digital platform will provide these girls and early career individuals with a continuous connection to experts from whom they can get knowledge, mentorship, and guidance on professional and personal development in respective domains.
